LADSON

We have many records of the Ladsons in the Province of South Carolina. We quote a few as follows:

From Hotten's Original List of Emigrants 1600 - 1700, page 385:

"August 13, 1679, Ladson, John in the Barq. Plantacion for Carolina, Aser Sharpe, Commander."

"1679 - In the list of emigrants from Barbadoes in the year 1679 we find the names of Robert Daniel, Thomas Drayton, John Ladson and Arthur Middleton - names which have since been interwoven with the history of the State."

From "South Carolina under the Prop's. Government," page 182.

We find many warrants for acres of land: "one for 400 acres in 1679" - "500 acres in 1681" - "a plantation of 500 acres in 1682 upon the Ashley River" and others.

"John Ladson served in the Commons House of Assembly from 1685 - 1698."

Journals printed - A. S. Salley

"The name Ladson seems to be a very rare one. According to data obtained from the family Bible of James H. Ladson, two brothers, John and Francis Ladson, came from Northamptonshire in England. This Bible was a gift to James H. Ladson from his Mother Judith Smith Ladson, and is inscribed on the flyleaf "James H. Ladson September 1, 1820, a present from his Mother Judith Ladson."

"John Ladson married Mary (daughter of Thomas and Mary Stanyarne)."
Note to his Mothers entry by J. H. Ladson, "I have the mourning ring of Mary Ladson who died, aged 40 years, December 8, 1707."

Abstracts from Records, The Court of Ordinary (1692 - 1700) A. S. Salley, page 262 -

"Oct. 1, 1698 Mary Ladson, Capt. William Smith and Jonathan Amory (merchant) executed their bond to Gov. Blake for Mrs. Ladson's faithful performance of the trust of Administratrix of the estate of John Ladson.
