

52. <sup>Captain</sup> Alexander Benjamin Lawton, C.S.A.  
 born 23 Sep 1809 <sup>at Robertville,</sup> son of Benjamin T.D. and Jane (marr.) Lawton, married (1)  
 c. 1830 his first cousin, Elizabeth Mary Brisbane (1810-1839), daughter of  
 Adam Fowler Brisbane, planter of Robertville, who married in 1803 in Savannah,  
 Mary Ann Morse (<sup>St. Helena Is.</sup> 10 Mar 1786 - 10 May 1854 Lawtonville). Their three children:  
 1. Mary Jane Lawton (1832-1856) married Montague LaFitte; their daughter,  
 Mary Ella LaFitte, born 7 Feb 1856, died shortly after her mother.  
 2. Martha Stoney Lawton, born 1834 at Robertville, married Judge Walter  
 Gwinn of Florida. No children.  
 3. Eusebia Lawton, born 1836, died in infancy.

Alexander Benjamin Lawton married (2) 1839 in Robertville his first cousin,  
 Narcissa Melissa Lawton (6 Mar 1817 Robertville - 16 Aug 1883 Oviedo, Fla.),  
 daughter of Rev. Winborn Aha Lawton and his first wife, Mary Elizabeth  
 Cater (25 Jun 1776 - 25 Feb 1823 Robert Cemetery), widow of Thomas Rhodes  
 (22 Apr 1775 Bridgwater, Eng. - 25 Apr 1809 Collier's Island, Se) and daughter  
 of Revolutionary War Captain Thomas Cater of Branford <sup>planter of Cater Hall, St. Peter's Par</sup> Voluntary Artillery (17 Dec 1751 -  
 20 Apr 1803) and his wife Rachel Miles (22 Dec 1755 - 30 Jun 1803), <sup>Alexander</sup> Benjamin  
 Lawton, planter of 6000-acre Summer Oaks Plantation, Thomasville, Ga.
