Born 22 June 1841 at Sw., son of William Seabrook and Dorothea (Furman) Lawton, graduated from the Citadel 8 Apr 1862 as cadet captain, commissioned 1st Lt., C.S.A., and assigned as Adjutant, 2nd Ga. Cavalry Regt. under the command of Col. William John Lawton (1824-1912), son of William Henry Lawton (1775-1827) of Robertville. ^{He was promoted to the rank of major during the war and upon} ~~After the war he married~~ Elizabeth McLeod, ^{of S.C.} but she died in childbirth, leaving him a young widower with two infant sons whom he placed in his mother's care. In 1871 he organized the Exchange Bank in Macon and married (2) 11 Jan 1872 Caroline (Carrie) Willingham (29 May 1853-2 Dec. 1921), daughter of Benjamin Lawton and Elizabeth Martha (Rayner) Willingham. She had attended Bessie Tift College and graduated from Stannton girl's College (now Mary Baldwin), Stannton, Va. In 1887 Richard organized the Merchants National Bank, serving as President. Despite his consulting the leading physicians of New York and Europe, he died of a malignant tumor 13 Jan 1892; interment was in Rose Hill Cemetery. The proceeds of a large insurance policy enabled his widow to rear their eight surviving children:
