He was licensed to preach at Black Swamp Baptist Church the same time as his father, J.J. Lawton, Dr. Joseph T. Robert and Holand (156-15) Dr. Lawrence Robert (sm. of Sem. John & Phuel (m. Kunji) Rebert) Yalk 24 Nov. 1807 - M. Adding Lawton Sept 1830 173 mulli 1819-13 001.887

He attended Furman University but graduated from Madison University in New York.

He married Mrs. M.S. Barksdale in Beaufort District in April 1836. They were married 44 years; he m (2) mrs. Josephine Pollul hauton

The churches he served were: Pipe Creek, Philadelphia in Barnwell County, Mt. Arnon, Hilton Head, Dawfuskie, Smyrna, Arnon, Sch. Concord and Allendale.

He was a trustee of Furman University.
