the connections of my family's

On p. 343 of the third edition  
my ~~father~~<sup>grandfather</sup> is 10. Richard Miller,  
tenth child of Lucretia Elvira  
Lawton and Milo Miller, mar.  
Jennie Bailey, at Ellenton, S.C.;  
4 children:

Essie Miller - etc.

Richard Miller - my Father

Wallace Miller - etc.

Russie Miller - etc.

My Father - Richard Miller, mar.  
Gertrude Johnson (not Brabham)  
of Martin, S.C.; 3 children (not 5);  
lived in Atlanta, Ga. (not Birmingham,  
Ala.)

There are many more connections

in my family, but I won't at-  
tempt to go into that at this  
time.

Dr. Peoples, I am filling out my  
D. A. R. papers and am hoping  
you can give us some vital  
information that we have not  
been able to unearth on two  
separate trips to Columbia,  
Barnwell, Allendale, Martin  
and the Court House in Sylvania,  
Screen County, Ga, the Caroliniana  
Library, etc. Plus two solid  
weeks of copying wills, death  
certificates, birth certificates, deeds,  
everything we could find pertaining  
to the Lawton line and Dr.  
George Moser, my ancestor.

On p. 340 you noted the birth date  
of Lucretia Eloira Lawton as  
30 Oct. 1816. From which source did  
you obtain this information, as  
we have not found it anywhere  
else? We have her will showing  
proof of marriage to Milo Miller  
from the Court House in Screen  
County, Ga. B ut do you know her  
exact death date (between July 15 and  
the end of July 1887)?

Also, do you know Milo Miller's  
birth and death dates, their  
marriage date, or where they  
might be buried?

We searched many cemeteries and my husband came back full of chiggers, but we could not locate any information as requested above. We had hoped to get down to Witten Head, but every step took so much more time than we anticipated, we were both worn out and too tired to go any further, so came home.

I would appreciate a reply from you, even if you do not have the information I am seeking.

After I turn in my DAR papers I can give you some more information on many members (~~that~~ found children) of Lucretia and Milo. But first - I must fill in my papers.

Would appreciate any information you may have as requested above and wish to thank you very much.
