


Fisher, Robert Singleton, Walter Singleton, Kate Lawrence, John Livingston and Adele Singleton of the second part, witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the love and affection which the said party of the first part bears to the said Helen M. Fisher, Robert Singleton, Walter Singleton, Kate Lawrence, John Livingston and Adele Singleton, and also in consideration of the sum of Five dollars the sum paid at or before the concluding and delivery of this present, and for other good and valuable considerations, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released, released, conveyed and confirmed, and of this present does grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, forever, the following described real estate situated in the 209th District G. M. in the county of Lawrence, State of Georgia, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on Central Railroad, as shown by the Deed of Survey of the lands of Thomas Hatchiss, deceased, recorded on the 17th day of December 1869, in the minutes of the Superior Court of said Lawrence county, on folios 385 and 386, and running thence north 26 degrees west 50.10 chains to a pine, thence north 4 degrees west 50 chains to black jack, thence north 58 degrees east 5.00 chain to stake, thence north 36 degrees west 66.00 chains to stake, thence north 45 degrees west 38 chains to corner on creek, thence following southward about 47 chains to where line leaves creek, thence south 17 degrees, west 78 chains to a stake, thence south 70 degrees east 16 chains to B tree stump, thence south 16 degrees west to stake just south of Central railroad, thence south 77 degrees west to stake #4 #4 east 60.70 chains to the point of beginning, containing nine hundred and eleven (91) acres, more or less, a part of said lands being herein adjoined and marked "Exhibit N," and made a part hereof.

To have and to hold all and singular the above granted premises, together with appurtenances, and every part thereof, unto the said party of the second part, his successors and assigns, forever in fee, upon trusts, never to lease, and to cut for uses.

interests and purposes hereinabove limited, described and declared - that is to say, upon trust to receive the issues, rents and profits of the said premises, and apply the same to the use of said Helen M. Fisher during the time of her natural life, or to sell the same, or said parts of second growth, trustee as aforesaid, may deem best, on such terms as to him shall seem meet, and reinvest the proceeds in real estate or goods and productive stock bonds, notes or mortgages and receive the issues, rents and profits, interest or income, arising therefrom and apply the same to the use of the said Helen M. Fisher during the term of her natural life, and after the death of the said Helen M. Fisher to convey by deed the said premises hereinabove described, or in case the property of the second growth, trustee as aforesaid, shall have sold the same and reinvested the proceeds as herein provided, the real estate, stock bonds, notes or mortgages, or the case may be, in which such proceeds shall have been reinvested, to Robert Singletary, Walter Singletary, Kate Lawrence, John Livingston and Adelle Singletary, share and share alike in fee.




