 paying tax.
 2 villagers and 1 smallholder with ½ plough.
 Value before 1066, 10s; now 8s; found waste.

Hugh also holds

- 2 HANDBRIDGE. Leofwin held it. 1 carucate of land paying tax.
 2 smallholders have ½ plough.
 The value was and is 3s.

- 3 'REDCLIFF'. Gunner held it. A third part of 1 hide paying tax. In
 lordship 1 plough, with 2 ploughmen. Waste when acquired.
 Value before 1066, 10s; now 6s 8d.

- 4 in WIRRAL Hundred
 CALDY. Erngeat held it; he was a free man. 1 hide paying tax.
 Land for 3 ploughs. In lordship 1, with
 1 smallholder.
 The value was 5s; now 10s.

11 Hugh (son of Norman) holds from the Earl

- * 1 In NORTHWICH Hundred
 LAWTON. Godric held it; he was a free man. 1 hide paying tax.
 Land for 3 ploughs. Waste.
 Woodland 1 league long and 1 wide; meadow, 1 acre.
 Value before 1066, 16s.

- * 2 LAWTON. Godric held it. ½ hide paying tax. Land for 3 ploughs. Waste
 Woodland 2 leagues long and 1 wide.
 Value before 1066, 20s.

- 3 BYLEY. Godric, Godwin and Arkell held it as 3 manors; they were
 free. 1 hide paying tax. Land for 2 ploughs.
 2 riders and 2 smallholders have 1 plough.
 Meadow, 2 acres; woodland, 2 acres.
 Value before 1066, 10s; now as much.

- 4 GOOSTREY. Godric held it; he was a free man. 3 virgates of land
 paying tax. Land for 1½ ploughs. It is and always was waste.
