

Scriven County } This Indenture made this fourth day of
April in the year of our Lord Eighteen
Hundred and forty eight; between W. S. Lawton of the state
and County aforesaid; duly constituted Guardian of the pro-
perty and person of Andrew S. Oliver of said State and County
of the one part; Dr Thomas G. Mims of the same place of
the other part. Witnesseth that whereas by virtue of an
order granted by the Honorable inferior Court of said County
when setting for ordinary purposes prescribes notice of
application having been given agreeable to the Statute
in such case made and provided on the first Monday
in November last to said W. S. Lawton Guardian as aforesaid
to sell a tract of Land belonging to the said Andrew
S. Oliver Situate lying and being in the County aforesaid
Known and distinguished as the land of Andrew S. Oliver
lying on Mobley's Pond and bounded by Lands of J. W. Ol-
iver, R. W. Lovett, W. W. Stark and others; containing two hun-
dred and thirty Acres more or less with the rights man-
ners appurtenance thereto belonging; after the said Tract of
Land was duly advertised; in conformity to Law the same
was put up and exposed to sale to the highest bidder at
the door of the Court House at Jacksonboro in said County
within the legal hours of sale on the first Tuesday in February
last past by said W. S. Lawton Guardian as aforesaid when said
tract of Land was knocked off to said Dr Thomas G. Mims at
the price or sum of Thirteen Hundred and sixty Dollars he
being the highest and best bidder; now for and in consider-

McBall Hervey Sheppard Willis Young John A. Groff Peter An-
nett John B. Denton and William Lovett Commissioners ap-
pointed by virtue of an act of the General Assembly passed
and approved off the 24th of December 1847: Said Commissi-
oners appointed for the purpose of Having moved the Cour-
t House and Jail to a site selected by said Commissioners
called Silver City and to dispose of the Lots in said Village and
make titles to the same: of the one part and Alexander Kemp
of the other part all parties of the State and County aforesaid
and: Witneseth that the said Moses N. McBall Hervey Sheppar-
d Willis Young John A. Groff Peter Annett John B. Denton &
William Lovett Commissioners aforesaid: for and in Consider-
ation of the sum of Thirty Dollars and fifty cents to them in
hand well and truly paid by the said Alexander Kemp: before
the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt where-
of is hereby acknowledged hath this day granted bargained
sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell and convey
unto the said Alexander Kemp: His Heirs Executors Administra-
tors and assigns: all that Tract of Land and parcel of Land sit-
uated lying and being in said County containing two acres
and twenty five links in width and three chains and fifty links
in depth: Known and distinguished in the plain of said vil-
lage by the Number thirty three (33) as a plot of the village
will more fully represent: the same being a part of a Tra-
ct of Land Originally Granted to Amariah Ennis for three
hundred and thirty six acres on the 22nd day of February 1836
together with all and singular the rights members and appurte-
nances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to the
only proper use benefit and behoof of the said Alexander Kemp

Lawton the first named person of the District of Buford & State of South Carolina and the second person of the State & County aforesaid: For and In consideration of the sum of: Five Hundred and fifty Dollars to us in Hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by: Major James Roberts of said State & County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged: hath bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell unto the said James Roberts his Heirs and assigns the following negro slave to wit Savility a woman: about twenty three years of age of dark complexion: and her child named Gailouese an infant about ten months old: To have and to hold the said negro slave to him the said James Roberts His Heirs and assigns forever in fee simple And we the said James S. Lawton and W. D. Lawton for ourselves our Heirs executors and administrators will forever: Warrent and defend the right and title to the said negro slave to him the said James Roberts his Heirs Executors and administrators against us the said James S. Lawton and Wm. D. Lawton our Heirs Executors and administrators and against the title of all and every other person claiming or to claim the same.
