 sometimes called Estate lands of Peter
 H. Dickerson, on the South by lands of Mrs. Jane
 Langston and others and on the West by the Public
 Road leading from Jacksonboro South on said Beaver
 Dam Creek towards Troyville

I have and I hold said bargained premises
 to the said Jimmy Green his heirs and assigns with
 all the rights titles members and appurtenances thereto
 belonging or in anywise appertaining forever in fee
 simple

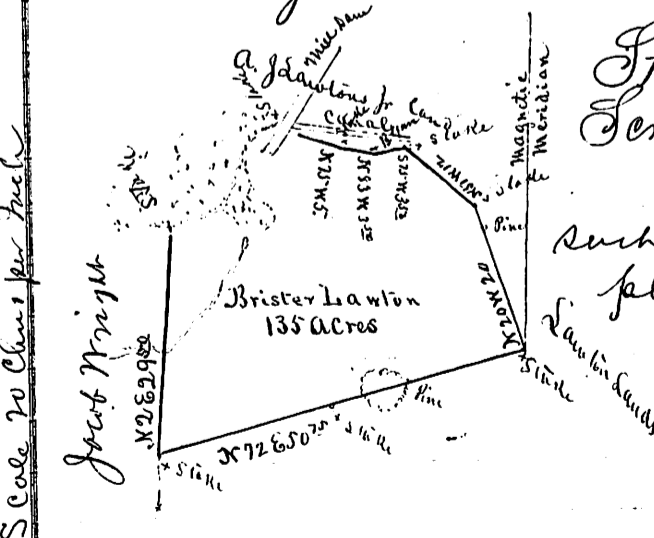

 defend the said premises unto him the said Brister
 and to his heirs and assigns against myself and
 my heirs and against all persons lawfully claiming or to
 claim the same.
