Grandma Louisa LEMON said that everybody pronounced the name like the lemon fruit and spelled it that way, so they decided to change their name instead of correcting people all the time."

Bartholomew County Probate Court - August Term, 1834 August 11, 1834 - Appointment of Administrator & Letters

In the Matter of the Estate of JOHN LAYMON, SR.

Be it remembered that on Aug. 11, 1834 comes DAVID LAYMON and made application for Letters of Administration upon the estate of JOHN LAYMON, SR., late of County of Bartholomew, State of Indiana, deceased, and also bring into open Court JOHN LAYMAN, JR. and said John being duly sworn upon oath says that the widow of said deceased in his presence renounced released and quit claim all right and title to the administration of the estate of the deceased and desired that same be committed to her son DAVID.

On Aug. 11, 1834 the said DAVID LAYMON executed and filed bond payable to the State of Indiana in the penal sum of \$400 conditioned according to law with JOHN LAYMAN of Shelby County and John Harper of Bartholomew County as security and taken the oath prescribed by law and Letters of Administration was granted unto the said DAVID LAYMON by the Court as administrator of the estate of said JOHN LAYMON, SR., deceased. Attest: Joseph McKinney, Clerk

Sept. 9, 1934 an inventory of the estate of JOHN LAYMON, SR. was taken by Joseph Chambers and Aaron Kendall the appraisers appointed by DAVID LAYMON, Adm. Sept. 12, 1934 a Public Sale was held by DAVID LAYMON, Admr. of the estate. A long list of items sold was given; only Laymon purchasers are listed below.

SAMUEL LEHMANN, LEYMAN, LAYMAN:\* Pennsylvania Militia; Pvt. & Ensign. Pension rejected, # R6338 (no proof of service).

\* his name was recorded various ways

February 12, 1845, Elizabeth LEYMAN declared in order to obtain his pension that "she is a resident of Philadelphia Co., widow of Samuel LEYMAN deceased." Her husband, Samuel, resided in Germantown during the first year of the Rev. War where he was apprenticed to the Blacksmith's ---- under Peter Smith. That the said Smith was a Tory & for that cause Samuel left the service of his master & entered into the service of a Company ?artif--? of the war & was engaged therein for sometime under a private contract.

That he continued to act in the Company until the summer of 1776 when he was called on under the Militia Laws of Penn. state to perform his term of 2 months service as a Pvt. which he did & from the service he was honorably discharged.

That again, in 1777, he performed another tour of duty of 2 mos. service as a Militia soldier & was, during the tour of duty in 1777, he was wounded in the flesh part of his hip. Which, in advanced age, he was afflicted with the wounds as he often told that the ball which he received, "he carryed" to the grave with him.

He was called again to service into Artifears (Artillery) dept. and at Valley Forge during the winter of 1777, then ordered to Allentown, called in 1780 to duty as a Pvt. in a Militia Company & served his term of 2 mos. Discharged from service in 1780.

Samuel, as a soldier spent all his time from 1776 to Spring of 1781, when he was appointed & confirmed as Ensign in the Penn. Militia. He served 2 mos. from about July 1781 .... She did not know what Regt. he was attached to. She stated there was no documentary of this service.

Samuel died February 10, 1836. She remains a widow. They married in --- 1783. Her maiden name was Elizabeth Tansfelder of Philadelphia Co. PA. He was wounded at the Battle of Amboy 1776 or 1777. Her husband said "he was entitled to a pension but he got his liberty and that was reward enough".

Attached to the file is a Marriage License., "By License dated Dec 5th the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty Three".

In his file is a record: "Return of officers legally chosen & nominated -- to the Militia Law of the State of Penny To be commissioned after latter? are approved of by his Excellency The President Commander in Chief of the Penny. Militia". On September 4, 1781, Saml LEYMAN was nominated Ensign in 2 Comp.. 6th Battalion.

In his file is a letter of 6/18/1887 from Chas Ridgway of Philadelphia: "... Samuel LEHMAN died Feby 10th 1836 aged 77 years. I think that at this time of the War the family resided in Germantown, Philada. Co. but the directory for 1816 lists his residence & place of business as 296x302 North Front, Philada. PA."


