**The purpose of this document is to attempt to trace the ancestors of Tripp, Chris, and Bryce Leavitt back to those who first emigrated to the United States. It started with the anecdotal and written research from relatives but required the capabilities of ancestry.com to build the ancestry behind closest relatives and nearest generations.**

**It is probably 90% accurate because mistakes are made with genealogies put together via the internet. Fortunately common sense does come into play, and I try not to repeat mistakes like Puritans born in Massachusetts before 1620!**

**One learns fascinating tidbits in doing this type of research. Patterns emerge. For instance, one imagines that none of these families were forced to migrate on because of economic circumstances based on so many remaining in the states to which they emigrated and the fairly long lives of many. This family basically came over in a couple of waves, the largest being during the "Great Migration" of Puritans from England during the 1600s. Most went to New England, some to Virginia. Later, there are emigrants from Germany going from the 1830s until the 1880s.**

**This is the state of play based on my knowledge in December 2009. Hopefully, it is a base to learn more in the future.**

n=56**








