Will of Phillip Lee

I give unto John Huffer his maintenance from
 my estate as long as he will reside thereon, with all ap-
 pointing of my Ex^{ors} hereafter mentioned to assist him in
 Recovering of 40 pounds Sterling per annum which descends to
 him after death of his grandmother
 I give unto Phillip Hine his maintenance of meat, drinks
 & clothes from my Plantation as long as he lives upon same
 I give & bequeath unto these my godchildren, one child
 of John Virgall one Joseph Hill, one of Louis Roger Earl &
 one of John Baker 500 pounds of sugar a piece
