* I do hope that you can look into the will of John Milan (3 June 1789 York Co S.C.) and determine if he is John the son of Samuel who married Judith Bartlett Cole.

The children he names were certainly all known child of John + Judith B. Cole Milan but ~~some say Judith Cole Milan died in Va + John in Laurens Co~~ So this one in York Co is a son (or other relative of) of the ~~four brothers who came to S.C. from Va son of Samuel Milan + Martha Gardner~~ - Maybe the phrase "Mary Ireland my granddaughter" will hold the clue.

Like you I have never heard from any of the descendants of Archibald

Until I heard from you I had contact with only sons Bartlett + John Jr with most from Bartlett - However since Bartlett's line was the only one I had in much detail others that I could not prove ^{any} connections with might have been from other lines.

I have exchanged with folks from son Benjamin + Jordan or Thomas + Mary Rush Adams Milan

I do not have a copy of a will for
John Milan 1825 - 1828 - only one for
John 1857 which is John Page Milan -

new material that I find + I hope
you will share anything that would
be new to me.

I was good to hear from you about the Milam Family. I think that the more of us who pool + share what we have + find the more complete our family story will be.

I have no documentation to help you in your DAR proof.

I have corresponded with many researchers + have discovered kin from many branches of the family - the basic lines seems to be pretty well charted for the first several generations then there are so many with the same name the web get tangled.

One point of disagreement/misunderstanding is with John + Judith

The DAR papers list John 1725 - 1788 ^{York Co SC} (1789)

Judith 1730 - 1775 post 1789

yet both death dates seem to be incorrect.

Also confusing the facts is a will in York Co S.C. of John Milam 1789 probated by son Thomas names dau - Nancy

granddau - Mary Ireland

wife - Judith (still living)

No clear data has ever been found on Judith - because some record had her as Mrs. - some felt her maiden name

was Bartlett + she was the widow of Mr - Cole
or Coles - I have never really dug into
either Bartlett, Cole or Coles but have had
several genesis published + have checked
all the Bartlett ^{and} or Cole data that I have
found in general sources.

The reference to Isaac Coles receiving John Milam
page seems worth checking - where did you
find that ref Vol 4 p 289 of what?

yes Bartlett was a much used name down
through the generations. The only Cole is
Larkin Cole Milam - son of John Milam +
Milly Pitts who was son of John 1753-1838
son of John 1725-1790 ^{or later}
son of Samuel.

Also do not know where Ferrill or Page
come from but I do know the Milam
family loved to use the same given
names + the maiden names of the wives.

In looking through those I have written
to one man seems to have Tenn connections -
a Thomas Milam in Tenn about 1820 - and he
did not know if they were connected with
Laure Co family -

where did you find / document the wife of Archibald (1729 - 1806) as Mary Wilson - all the records at the Alamo library do not show her name (as grandmother of Ben Rush Milam) and some where else I had seen Susan so wonder where you found Mary Wilson.

Was Diataphus a Milam?

or was she a Dodge who married a milam -

Samuel + Martha Gardner Milam + their three sons are well documented -

second son, Thomas, ^{+ his sons} stayed mostly in Va + Ohio and upper mid west.

Archibald family also mostly went west - many ended up in Texas as did the famous Ben for whom Milam Co Texas is named etc.

Four of John's sons came to Laurens Co S.C. but I have data on Bartlett only - (my line) He has a dozen children + they all have large families - but I do not see Diataphus among any of them (as child or spouse)

I have about 15 pages + if you want to go over them yourself I will be glad to share for zero cost of 10¢ page + postage.

My line is through John Milam + Judith Bartlett Cole
their son Bartlett Milam + Elizabeth Guin
their son Riley Milam + Rachael Sims.

Would love to exchange if your research touches on any of these families in Laurens Co S.C.
