These letters seem to work primarily off of the Bartlett Milam side of the family.

I have searched out the Euharlee Presbyterian Church cemetery in Bartow County and have photo's of the Milam headstones. All of them to my knowledge were decedents of Bartlett and Elizabeth Milam. I've also a photo of the headstone of Farril Milam and his sister Nancy Milam. The stone reads "In Memory of Farril Milam who departed this life Dec. 21st 1869, aged 85 years.----- Greater love hath no man than this. That a man lay down his Life for his friends.----- Nancy Dau. of Bartlett & Elizabeth Milam, died Mar. 31, 1883, age 92 yrs.

That is the best I can do to date to show that Thomas was the son of John Milam, Sr. By the way what I have copied shows that John Sr. was an emigrant from England. Your comment that he was born in Virginia was interesting. Can you give me some more on him and Samuel Milam (Mileham) and his wife Martha Gardner. I just do not have much on them. If you have prepared any family sheets I would appreciate a copy. I have already prepared family sheets on Doctor Thomas Milam who was the son of William Milam and his wife Mary Pasley. Also on Williams father, Bartlett Milam and his wife Elizabeth Gwinn. Also on Bartlett's father John Milam Sr. and his wife Judith ? Bartlett. I will be glad to share any of this with you that you may desire. Just let me know and I will secure some copies for you.

I cannot at this time locate much help on Coleman. This is because I've not spent time searching out this particular side. At some future time I may be of help since others are working on the Milams also.

I'm pretty excited, just now I've hung up my phone talking with Mr. John Loud, President of the Georgia Chapter of the Son's of the American Revolution. He called to confirm my mailed notification of acceptance and has asked me to come to Atlanta to their meeting to be presented my certificate. Great news.

Sorry about the above, just got carried away. Let me know how I may help and I will be more than happy to do so. I've also copies of the references in The Compendium of American Genealogy, The History of Bartow County, Ga., on John Milam.

I've read with interest your ancestor notice in the May/June 1984 issue of the Genealogical Helper. My family line also includes the Milam family from Laurens County, South Carolina. My Milams left Laurens County in the mid 1850's coming to Cass County (now called Bartow County, Georgia). I have quite a bit of information on the Milam family and would be glad to share my genealogy with you.


You listed a John Milam from Laurens County, S.C. born 1790. My line comes from Dr. Thomas Milam 1807-1874; he was my great-great grandfather. He was the son of William Milam 1777-1844. He was the son of Bartlett Milam Sr. C-1750-1822, born in Halifax County, Virginia, and died in Laurens County, S.C. He was the son of John Milam Sr. C-1725, emigrated from England, died C-1788.

We believe that this John Milam's father was Samuel Mileham/Milam. The Robert Pasley line came into the Milam family when William Milam married Mary Pasley. I also have info on this line if you are connected here also.

My records indicate that Bartlett Milam Sr. was a Patriot in the American Revolution. His father John Milam Sr. is also listed as a Patriot in the Am. Rev. This John Milam Sr had several children, one of whom was John Milam, Jr. I believe he was a private from Virginia also in the Am. Rev. born 6-12-1753. Bartlett Milam had several children one of whom was John Page Milam born Mar. 26, 1772 in Halifax Co., Va.

I hope some of this might be tied in with your Milam line. If so, and we can get together on our genealogy, I would appreciate your writing back. To me genealogy is very interesting and a very important part of my life. I have made many friends through my genealogical searches and hope that we may do so also.
