(Deed Bk. G, p. 226, Laurens Co., SC.) 1810 US Census Laurens Co., SC: Thomas Milam, born ante 1765, 1 male 1794-1800, 2 males 1784-1794 (sons Coleman & John); wife Elizabeth, born ante 1765, 2 females 1794-1800, 1 female 1784-1794 (probably wife of Coleman.) 7 Feb. 1811 Thomas Milam witnessed deed of Charles Little & wife to James Leake for 180 acres on Duncan Creek, part of which said 180 acres would be sold 1 Oct. 1816 by Thomas Milam's son: Coleman Milam. (Deed Bk. J, p. 215 Laurens Co., SC.) 15 June 1811 Thomas Milam owned land bordering 200 acres on Duncan Creek which Robert Creswell sold to James Leake for \$350, said 200 acres sold by Sheriff John Clark to said Robert Creswell as former property of Ashford Clary. Thomas Milam died 1823 in Bartow Co., Ga. and was buried there in a grave which is now lost.
