Administration 18 September 1751 to John Owen a Principal Creditor, Susannah Webb the Relict dying without taking administration, and John Webb, Uncle and Guardian to John Webb and William Webb infant children of deceased, first renouncing. Administration 5 September 1759 to John Strettell executor of will of John Owen now deceased.

William Webb was born in Northampton, England, and died at Charleston S.C. at 7 o'clock P.M. Sept. 29 - 1749. He married Sarah Peromeau who was born in New England 16 January 1715 - & died at Charleston 3 o'clock A.M. Sept. 30 - 1749 eight hours after her husband.

They left two sons - John born at Charleston S.C. - 22nd Sept - 1744 (old style) (3rd Oct new style) & died on the road in his Gig, 28 Dec. 1807 on his way home from Columbia where he had just been handsomely elected to office of Register of Deeds & Conveyance for Charleston Dist.

William, his brother, was born in Charleston Nov. 1745 - & died in Cannonborough 13th Feb. 1813

John Webb married Mary Doughtly* who was born 28 July 1749 (O.S.) on the 3rd Jan'y 1769 at Dan'l Cannon's Queen St. house, Charleston. She died 28 Oct 1782 - They had eight children -

Daniel C. Webb's Grandfather by Mother's side was Thomas Doughty - who married Mary Truvel - he died 29 of June - 1755 - aged 57 years, and left three children.

2 Sarah married James Wakefield and left six children Mrs. Mary Cannon died 8th March 1789 aged 66 years

Mr. + Mrs. Cannon by their second marriage had one daughter Martha who survived them was born 2nd Oct. 1760 - (D. 2nd Nov. 1814.)

Martha Cannon adopted, during her father's life-time Mrs. John Webb's two children Mary D. + Daniel C.

Mrs. Pinckney's Daughter Anna Maria and

Mrs. Wakefield's 5 Daughters + 1 Son. Thus did this good old gentleman Mr. Cannon and his most noble Daughter take into their charge 9 motherless children who divided by will

the whole of their two estates with a small exception.
Martha Cannon received D. C. Webb into her arms
from his dying mother when he was but
three months old and was truly a brother to him
having lived together as brother & son for
32 years until her death - in his House.

Cannon's brought on 2nd November 1814 aged
5-4 years & 1 mo. only - she was one of the most
exemplary Christians & best of women.
