War period) records obtained on the Greer family of Greenville, Spartanburg and Union Counties, and have traced my wife's maternal line back through Mary Greer-dau, to Isaac Greer-father, to John Greer-g-father. At this point I'm unable to locate father of John Greer who died in Greenville County - WDH

This book on the Waters genealogy appears to be very good and should assist in giving leads for verification of lines of descent to the wife of Thomas Miles. I have done little research on these families, but the notes I have assembled to date have, on hasty checking, been verification in every instance of statements in this book.

If I may make a couple suggestions for further research:

1. Trace the migratory trail of the Waters and Farrow families for possible assistance in uncovering the origin of Thomas Miles.
2. Thomas Miles appears on the jury in Spartanburg County so this was his legal residence. Although Charles Miles name appears in the public records of Spartanburg county he does not appear on the jury indicating this was not his legal residence. Review the references to his name in Union County and verify if his name appears on the jury. If they were brothers possibly they lived near each other on the county line.
