Thank you also for getting the cemetery cleaned up so beautifully- i had never been there before and was so interested- I enclose a small bit for the cemetery fund-

I am endeavoring to get back to Englannd to search further for George Norton's family- I tried in April and I am pretty sure i found his beloved brother John- i searched old church record and found John's death- at about the right time- I do not think the Cotterstock ones are our Georges immediate family -but I wanta do back and search some more- you know George dont you- the great grandfather of Dorothy Phoebe Mosse- whose will Jack Ladson got for us all from Barbados- Jack called me the other day- he says he thinks Georges wife was Original Jacksons sister-

When i was in England I had an H of a time trying to find about anything- or where to go for info- they do not have a central archives bit- so we went by

Jack Ladson had had a genealogist named TONGE look up Norton in England and he said it was Cotterstock Hall which was the family seat but i dont think so- cousins maybe-

train to North Hamton- to Warwick etc- and darned little when y u get there- and no help- but did meet a lady as we were leaving Warwick- (hwere i found the death notice of Johnin 1668) This lady named Turpin was endeavoring to find an american connection named Lionel Fitzherbert Turpin who supposedly came to Charleston from British Guiana in 1898 - (very late along) and tho i tried mightily writing to charleston- several agencies - I had no luck-

anyhow- this lady said that the Mormans had copied off all the records in England and i should g g to Birmingham and check their records- so i hope to do that-

I want to find a will if possible- of Georges father mentioning the names of Geo, Hannah, Mary and John- then i will feel i have the right one-

The people living at Cotterstock Hall were just darling to us- (we made nice new friends) but the dates were not right (I dont think)

Incidentally my very nice cousin George Mosse Norton got quite a jolt when he was in Salt Lake city to see that Dr Geo Mosse had been baptized again- bet it is his 3rd- I myself am not sure i wanta be sealed up with all those ancestors- like that old boy you mentioned who destroyed the books at Durham cathedral-

also found another gent- Bishop Howland who belongs to my Jhn Howlands family- the B,sh received the body of Mary Queen of Scots after her demise at Peterborough Cathedral and very promptly buried her- (was he expecting trouble?)

mus saw off- did love seeing you both and thank you again for all you did for everybody- youse is done good(as E Newman wd say in ~~strictly speaking~~)
