I understand you have some geneal ogical data on the Reynolds and Oswald families. I am very anxious to learn something about Martha Oswald, who married before 1770 James Reynolds, son of William and Elizabeth (Evans) Trueheart Reynolds. James was born Mar. 9, 1745, and died after 1784. Martha (Oswald) Reynolds' mother was a Tucker. Their daughter, Elizabeth Reynolds, married John Townsend. They were the grandparents of my grandmother, Joanna Adelila Townsend, who married Dr. Oliver James Hart.

I have a wonderful record of the Reynolds Genealogy, but know nothing about Martha Oswald beyond the fact her mother was a Tucker. I believe they lived around Beaufort. There is a record of Martha's and John Townshends (the old spelling) marriage in the St. Helena Parish Register.

If you have any record of the forebears of Martha Oswald and will share it with me, I shall appreciate it very much. I shall be glad to copy the Reynolds Genealogy and send you if you would care to have it. I have been told the Reynoldses owned Hunting Island at one time.

I have a small chart of some early Oswalds but there is no clue as to Martha. It starts with William Oswald, emigrant from Scotland, who died the middle of the 17th century, married Mary _____.
