and born St Helena Is. both taken sick same time
and died same day. buried on St Helena or James Is
Chas Is.
- 1111 Ann Elija Osnald b. Nov 26-1826 on St Helena Is
married (Ludmgo) Richard Reynolds of St Helena Is
on April 18, 1849 - she died Nov 8, 1859. buried Bpt Bapt ch. yd.
she was a member of this church. age 33 yrs old.
Richard Reynold b. about 1800 St Helena Is. went
to Portruges Military Academy in Vermont. he was warden
in St Helena Epis. Church in Beaufort SC he first
married Margaret MeKe (she was born 1808 Beaufort
and died July 9, 1844 age 36. buried St Helena Episcopal Ch-
urch Beaufort SC. by this union they had John, Sally + Margaret
and had single. John's name appears on tablet on this
church Sally buried in Spartanburg S.C. + Margaret
a child buried by mother. we are told Richard d -
Reynolds was a Mason at Beaufort SC. John ^{Nov 1861}
was killed in 1863 in Va. in service CSA. Bpt. Tol. Art.
John studied medicine + played violin and sister
Sally was a poetess + played piano at age of 16 yrs -
Magnolia Cem. also has John's name on it in Chas.
Confederate monument. John, Sally were Episc. ch members -
John went to school in Beaufort + one day hid his
books so that he could see boat Admiral Farragut
was an at dock in Beaufort S.C. on visit

Richard Reynolds^{jr} was married to Margaret
McKee April 30 - 1834

her children were

1. John McKee born Feb 2 - 1840 ^{Beaufort SC} Epis.
killed in Va. 1863 in service of C.S.A.
tomb slab on St Helena Church. Bt. SC. died single
2. Sarah Louisa (known as Sally) Epis.
b. Feb 18 - 1843 d. about 1863 buried
in Spartaury SC died single (a poetess)
3. Margaret b. about 18~~38~~³⁵ - d. ab. 18~~45~~³⁹
died small child buried in McKee
lot St Helena Epis. Ch. in Beaufort SC
(negroes said Yankees took Margaret's
tombstone on a fire back) I have a
sample of little Margaret's golden hair
in our Reynolds desk (Florence J. Lantier)

Mrs Margaret McKee (Reynolds) (1st wife)

b. 1808 d. July 9. 1844 age 36 yrs buried
in St Helena Ch. yd. in McKee lot.

John Bytherood Conrall Tombstone
in Reynolds lot. Beaufort Bapt Ch. Case.

John Bytherood Conrall son of Robert and
Ann Bytherood Conrall who departed this
life on November 23, 1832 Age 16 mos. and
5 days. b. 1830.

Thus Robert Conrall (Dr) first married Harrietta
McKee sister of Margaret McKee (Mrs Rich. Reynolds)
Dr Robt Conrall's second wife was Ann
Bytherood - he is said to be buried at
Grahamville S.C.

After her death Ann Bytherood (Mrs Robt Conrall
married John Bell of Beaufort S.C.
Their home was that of Mrs Harry Danner
who lives ^{there} now in two story house with
basement. Ann was living up to 1847.

It was at this Bell house that the Reynolds
girls Corot & Addie went to school and there
was a Cove nearby and Corot with her little
hoop skirt fell in Cove and grand father
Richard Reynolds sent Carriage for her &
they never went back. F.D.L.

wife was Martha Oswald sister of Ann
Eliza Oswald Reynolds.

It is supposed that Martha Oswald is buried
at Jorells on the Little Baynard plantation which
was originally called "White Hall" but none
of us could find it, but there are tombstones
on this place. ask Maner Boates who lives &
owns land there.
