Also a daughter of Amos H (Capt) & Elvina Horton m<sup>r</sup>  
John Peebles Jr - After the Rev this Horton family went  
to Wake Co N.C. then to Ala around 1830 - I have the Horton  
line documented from Barnabas Horton (from Eng 1630) to the  
family here in Greene Co - Except the link of Joshua III to Amos  
Horton Sr - his son, but I can not find proof.

My plans are to go to Eng. and Scotland the  
last of April. There is a ~~a~~ County or Dist - what ever they  
are called <sup>over there</sup> in Scotland named 'Peebles'. I will go there and  
hope I will find Fife. Should I find anything about  
our David or his family will write you when I get  
back.
