While reading my husband's SAR Magazine, I noticed your query about copies of Anne B. Peebles' Peebles/Ante 1600-1962. can't help but be curious as to whether or not your ancestor could have been the father (or some relationship) to the two boys, Henry and Lewis, as mentioned on page 29 of the book ? They are mentioned as <u>must</u> be the sons of William⁶, however there seems to be some confusion about it in the article.

This letter is just a long shot that you might have other information concerning the mother of the two mentioned boys who married 2nd a Morris and had five Morris boys.

I research the Morris line which is my husband's line and continually run into confusion about Jane Darling being the wife first of William Peeples. It has always been very strange to me that one of the 5 Morris boys would have been named for his mother's first husband, a Peeples. I am referring to Alonzo Peeples Morris who is mentioned on page 31 of the article. This Alonzo Peeples Morris is my husband's Great Grandfather.

Back to page 29 of the article, one paragraph states Henry and Lewis being closely associated with the Morris family in Henry county, GA. and that they must be the sons of William as I mentioned before, but the very next paragraph seems to contradict that. It mentions the tradition seems to be erroneous in that William's wife was Jane Darling basing this on the fact that among the descendants of Henry & Lewis, none of them carry the name Jane or Darling. This could very well be true however, all of the descendants of the 5 Morris boys carry the name Darling.

Enough of my musing, Dr. Peoples, I just felt I needed to touch base with you in HOPES there might be some additional information available that I was unaware of. I copied the pages from Anne B. Peebles book which is at the Dallas Public Libary.
