

Hi There,

Further to my telephone conversation with Linda this morning, our firm has been retained to identify and locate the paternal heirs of an estate. In this instance, a maternal heir has provided that her Uncle Charles (Decedent's Father) and Aunt Noel were her only paternal family and that there weren't any other paternal heirs. The Queens NY Surrogate's Court has not accepted this and requires that a diligent search be conducted to identify any unknown paternal heirs.

The following is what I know about the family:

Charles (aka Charlie) Peeples (Decedent's father) was enumerated with his wife Nellie Peples [sic] and daughter Beatrice in Queens, New Yorkin 1930. He was reported to be 26 years of age, negro and born in Georgia. He died in New Yorkand we have been unable, thus far, to receive a copy of his DC.

Charles had a sister, Noel Peeples who married Leroy Small in New York. According to her certificate, in 1934 she was 28 years of age, colored, single, born in Savannah, Georgiaand her father was William (no surname reported) and her mother was Alice Porter, this was her first marriage.

Based on this information, searches were conducted in Savannah, Georgiafor the family of William and Alice Peeples (soundexed) with children Charles and Noel, with no luck. However, I did find a number of city directory listings (1903, 1904, 1908, 1911, 1915, 1921) for William Peeples in Savanna, the majority of which had him working on tug boats. In the 1921 directory, William Peeples was listed at 241 Arnold. Also at that address was Joseph Peeples.

The death certificates for William and Joseph Peeples were obtained, as was an death notice for Joseph. These records report the following:

William H. Peeples died January 23, 1922 in Savannah, GA, a resident of 241 Arnold Street. According to his death certificate, he was born August 16, 1873 in Hilton Head, South Carolinaand his father was identified as William H. Peeples, mother unknown. This record also reports that he was married to Eliza Peeples. In addition, the informant of the death was Joe Peeples, 241 Arnold Street and his place of burial was simply reported as Hilton Head, SC.

Joseph Peeples died November 6, 1958 in Savannah, GA, a resident of 521 Liberty Street. According to his death certificate, he was born March 11, 1899 in Hilton Head, South Carolina and his father was William Peeples, mother "Julia ?". The informant of the death was his daughter, Janie Hamilton and he was interred in SpanishWell Cemetery, Hilton Head, SC.

A death notice for Joseph Peeples stated "The relatives and friends of Rev. Joseph Richard Peeples, Mr. and Mrs. John Hamilton, Mr. and Mrs. Charlie Peeples, Jamaica, N. Y., Mr. and Mrs. Favin Shepard, Jamaica, N. Y., Mrs. Bessie Garrett, Mr. and Mrs. Nathaniel Frazier, Mr. Robert Gordon and family are invited to attend the funeral of Rev. Joseph Richard Peeples".

These records suggest that Joseph (born 1899), Charles (born ca 1904) and Noel (born ca 1906) could all be siblings and children of William Peeples of Hilton Head, SC.

I have attached scans of the documents that I have located thus far and would appreciate your assistance in establishing the parents of Charles Peeples and determining his siblings and their descendants to the level of First Cousins Once Removed. I would like to start by authorizing up to 10 hours of research time. My client in this matter is very anxious, in which case I would appreciate an update on any findings or efforts or by this Friday (January 18) or when the time has been used, which ever comes first.

Dear Cathy,

I am sending you the Peeples Family research findings with sources cited. Documents that you sent to us, such as the death certificates for Joseph Peeples and William Peeples, were cited as "previously found" although I located them, also.

The <u>Hilton Head Cemeteries</u> (see attachments) indicated that there were one hundred and fifty-two people enumerated in the Spanish Wells Cemetery. Neither William Peeples nor any other Peeples, Small, or Hamilton family members were listed in it. <u>The Archaeological Survey of Hilton Head Island, Beaufort County, South Carolina</u> (See attachment) states there are apparently many unmarked graves in Spanish Wells. That would explain why William Peeples' grave could not be found there. The other cemeteries of Hilton Head Island did not list any of the people in this research group. (See <u>Native Cemeteries Attachment</u>)

Leroy Small and Noal Small were enumerated in the 1930 United States Federal Census for Manhattan, New York as "roomers" and "married". No children were enumerated with them. (See attachment) Although the previously found marriage certificate for Leroy Small and Noal Peeples was dated <u>February 10, 1934</u>, they appear to be the same people.

There were no marriage records for William Peeples and Julia, Alice, or Eliza. Julia Peeples did not show up in any records searched except as "mother" on Joseph Peeples death certificate. Alice Porter was listed as "mother" of Noal Peeples on Noal and Leroy Small's marriage certificate. Eliza was "widow" on William Peeples' death certificate. All of these documents were previously found. Additional records could not be located.

Bessie Garrett, Nathaniel Frazier, Robert Gordon/Gorman and Favin Shepard, were only found in Joseph Peeples' Funeral Notice, listed as "relatives and friends" and did not have enough information to search or establish the relationship to the Peeples' family.

I was unable to find any additional information about Charles Peeples, his parents, his siblings, or their descendants to the level of first cousins once removed.

38BU832, is an extensive shell midden previously eroding from the bank into the Skull Creek marsh, but now protected by a bulkhead. The site is situated east of Talbert Cemetery and covers about 0.4 acre (0.2 hectare). Although only a single Middle Woodland ceramic was recovered, the site evidences abundant shell and is in a wooded area, so site integrity is expected to be high. This site is recommended as eligible for inclusion in the National Register.

38BU841, Stoney Cemetery, consists of two black cemetery clusters containing at least 50 graves from the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. The site, which encompasses about 0.7 acre (0.3 hectare), is still being used and is situated adjacent to Skull Creek in the Hickory Bluff area of the island. The site contains the skeletal population of black individuals with considerable time depth and probable kinship affiliation. The information which could be obtained through bio-archaeological and osteological studies can be obtained from no other source; this cemetery is considered eligible for the National Register as an archaeological site.

38BU860, is a nineteenth and twentieth century black cemetery which may date from the antebellum period. It is situated on Old House Creek and contains about 100 marked graves. The cemetery is fenced and encompasses about 1.5 acres (0.6 hectare). The cemetery was located on an artificial rise created by a probable aboriginal shell midden. This cemetery evidenced no grave goods except for plates placed into concrete gravestones. There are apparently many unmarked graves, a human metatarsal was found on the surface of a freshly dug grave. The site contains the skeletal population of black individuals with considerable time depth and probable kinship affiliation. The information which could be obtained through bio-archaeological and esteological studies can be obtained from no other source; this cemetery is considered eligible for the National Register as an archaeological site.

38BU864, is a shell midden at the top of Bram's Point. This spit of land has been subjected to heavy erosion and the site appears to have been redeposited on the beach. Shells and a small quantity of heavily worn pottery were recovered from 600 feet (185 meters) of beach. The bluff was examined and no remnant pockets of shell could be found. Because of this extensive erosion and lack of site integrity this midden does not appear to be eligible for the National Register.

38BU870, Honey Horn Church and Cemetery, is situated at the headwaters of Jarvis Creek on Honey Horn Plantation. The site includes an early twentieth century black church (or "praise




