The Charleston, S. C. "Times", 4 April 1808: "The date of Dr. George Mosse's birth is not known, but public records state he was a graduate of the University of Dublin, Ireland, and came to America just before the Revolutionary War. He settled on St. Helena Island; after his young wife, Miss Elizabeth Martin, died, he married the sister of his friend and neighbor, William Norton. Dr. George Mosse was taken a prisoner in May 1781 on the prison ship, "Forbay" in Charleston, S. C.

"On 26 October 1800 he helped organize the First Baptist Church at Savannah, Ga., serving as the first deacon. He was the organizer of the old Savannah Medical College and also a charter member of the first Medical Society in Georgia. He died 17 Feb. 1808 in his 67th year. A widow and seven (7) daughters survive him."

The wife of Dr. George Mosse and mother of his seven daughters was DOROTHY PHOEBE NORTON, born 10 November 1751 (St. Helena's Parish Register, S.C.G.& H. Magazine Vol. XXIII, p. 141), baptized 30 March 1752 by Peasely; she died at their Black Swamp, S. C. Plantation in 1808. She was the daughter of Jonathon Norton of St. Helena's Island who was born 14 July 1705, baptized 4 May 1726 by Jones, married 16 May 1732 Mary Ann Chaplin, spinster (SCH&G Magazine Vol. XXIII, p. 140 and p. 47 "Mary Ann Chaplin, Spin.: Da. John & Phoebe (Ladson) St. Helena, born 22 July 1716, bapt. 24 Dec. 1732 by Jones, married by same 16 May 1732 Jonathon Norton, Bach.") "John Chaplin, father to Mary Ann Chaplin, buried on St. Helena, 5 January 1752, 69½ yrs" born 1682 (p. 49) The Will of Jonathon Norton was made 14 Apr. 1774, a copy is available in the Charleston Public Library.

NORTON FAMILY RECORD:

George Norton is named in the original lists of "persons of Quality who went from Great Britain to the American Plantations" p. 73: "To the Barbadoes, George Norton - 22 yeres", 2 May 1635". His Will dated 3 May 1665 is in St. Michael's Parish, Barbados. Therein he leaves various amounts of sugar to Mrs. Thomas Norris, a friend, to John Clark, a poor fatherless child whom he has befriended, to Robert Hales and Anne Stuart, his servants, to his brother, JOHN NORTON of Killingsworth, Warwickshire, Eng., to his sister, Mrs. Mary Bailey, wife of Richard Bailey of Coleman Street, London, and to his sister, Mrs. Hannah Walker, wife of Edward Walker of Barbados.

He also left to his son, JOHN NORTON, his interest in the Cape Fear adventure "where John is presently my agent". His estate is to be divided into three parts, two of which are to go to his son, John Norton, when he reaches the age of 21. The other third part was to be divided between his twin daughters, Mary (eldest) and Hannah.

Executors are: John Norton, Richard Hawkins, Anthony Lane, Edward Pelham, Armiger Warren, etc. Proved 12 May 1665. He was father of:

JOHN NORTON who came from Barbadoes to Charleston in 1671, married before 1691, SARAH FITCH, dau. of Jonathan & Elizabeth Fitch, Quakers (who came to Carolina in 1678, Jonathan dying before 1691 when his dau. Sarah transferred certain property she had inherited from her father). John Norton's Will is dated 30 Sept. 1705, the year of his death; their 4th son was JONATHAN NORTON (14 July 1705-28 Apr. 1774) who married 16 May 1732 Mary Ann Chaplin (22 July 1716-10 Jan. 1764).

"DR. GEORGE MOSSE.... A Sketch of a family prominent in Georgia and South Carolina." by W. H. Robert, Centreville, Miss. 1891:

"George Mosse was a native of Ireland, and coming to the United States a thoroughly educated gentleman, as well as physician, he

settled in South Carolina on the Island of St. Helena, near Mr. William Norton, a highly educated and cultivated gentleman whose descendents are now numerous in Georgia and South Carolina and other places. They were Episcopalians, and Dr. Mosse marrying the sister of Mr. Norton, they lived for a number of years on terms of intimacy and reared large families there. Dr. Mosse employed a private teacher in his family and gave his seven daughters the best educational advantages of that time. When advanced in life he gave his daughters the advantages of a boarding school in the city of Charleston. His eldest daughter, Esther Marie, who married Capt. P. McKenzie, had a piano and a guitar with keys. Jane, the fourth daughter, the mother of Dr. James Stoney Lawton of Atlanta, took lessons on the piano, one having been given to her by Aunt Graham, a wealthy sister of her mother.

Dr. George Mosse in process of time became a Baptist. As there was no church there he went to the Main, and became a member of the Euhaw Church and was baptized by the Rev. Joseph Cook. Soon his wife and her brother, William Norton, followed, and in time they constituted a church, and built a church on St. Helena. Dr. Mosse, besides his profession of medicine, carried on a tannery, and kept a large store for the benefit of the community, generally. Three of his seven daughters married on St. Helena, and he then removed to Savannah, Ga. where he was Port Physician and a deacon of the First Baptist Church. After six or seven years, in 1806, he moved to Black Swamp, S. C. and bought a large quantity of land from some of the families who emigrated to Mississippi in 1806: Peter Robert, Rev. Alex. Scott, John Grimball, and Cheney and others. He was useful in the church at Robertville as deacon, but lived to make only one crop when he died in 1808 and was buried on his own plantation. His wife followed him in seven weeks and was buried by his side. In process of time Professor Terence Hughes, the second husband of Aunt Hetty M. Hughes, died and was buried by them, and so these three graves were alone in an old field and now are not known to any living person. Dr. George Mosse was a good and great man, useful in his day and time, and his numerous descendents will be glad to have this reliable data concerning him. These have been prepared by the assistance of Mrs. Martha Norton Buckner, now of Waycross, Ga."

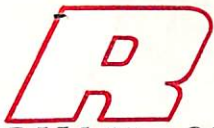
MEMORANDUM on "ISHAM" name.
By Anne B. Peebles 1960

This as a first name is found only in Peebles lines of dscts. of ABRAHAM. In Henrico (now part Chesterfield) in middle 1600s was a prominent family named ISHAM, and a dau. m. an EPES, and there were quite a few ISHAM EPES in the scattered family. Wm. Epes owned land in Pr.Geo. not far from William Peebles II, a little further south, and adjoining land patented by Wm. Peebles III. There is a deed in Pr.Geo. 7 Nov. 1726: Richard Carlile to Wm. Peebles III, who had m. Richard's dau. MARY, and the witnesses were Fras.(Francis) Epes, Jr., Isham Epes, Litt: (Littlebury) Epes. Whether that Isham lived down there or not, I do not know, almost all Pr.Geo. records destroyed in 1864. However, Abraham Peebles must have married, probably as his 2nd wife, an Epes; either that or close friendship.

There are ISHAM PEEBLESes all over the map: Vide:

- ISHAM SR. of Beaufort, b. 1725-30 Va.
ISHAM Jr. of Beaufort, b. 10 Oct. 1779 there.
ISHAM SR. of Barnwell, placed because of use of Darling name, also because of tradition of "four bros. came to S.C." (Henry of Barnwell, John of Beaufort - dscts in Texas know they are bros. - William, a soldier proved bro. of John, and this Isham, born 1765-70.
Isham Jr. of Barnwell, b. 1784/5 S.C., died 1850/60 Tallapoosa Co. Ala.
ISHAM, son of Lewis Sr. of Kershaw (latter bro. of Isham Sr. of Beaufort), born c. 1784, d. ante Mar. 1822. Bro Wm. who went to Henry Co., Ala., his Admr.
ISHAM PEBBLES, b. "ante 1785" Defaulter 1801 tax Warren Co., Ga. Capt. Stephen Marshall's Dist. Probably same as:
Isam Peoples, b. 1770/1, in Lancaster Co., 1820, 1830, 1840, aged 45 up, 50/60, 70/80; large family 7 dau., 3 sons, names unknown. This is the Isham of p. 144 Census of Pensioners, Revolutionary, etc. Pensioner for Military service. Age 70 in 1841. War 1812 apparently. This Isham apparently son of Henry of Lancaster, youngest son of Abraham, who moved Lanc. to Warren Co., Ga. 1790. One of HIS sons was the Jesse who was a Justic in Kershaw, and is buried in now Lee Co., then part of Lanc. (I've been to the grave.) Many things indicate this Isham is placed correctly.
Isam, b. 1802, son of John and grandson of Henry of Lanc./Warren, with father John 1820 Jackson Co., Ga. 1826, m. 1824 Oglethorp Co. Ga. to Jane Crowley. Probably same as below, later went Ala.
Isham, 1830 Alachua Co., Fla., 20/30 wife and 2 f. under 5, probably same as Isham above who went to Ala. I've seen letters he wrote. He perhaps was the Isham in St. Clair Co., Ala., later - no date.
ISHAM, b. 1803 SC, son of William, Gr.son of Lewis Sr., Kershaw, to Ala. with father, Henry Co., have dscts sent by one.
ISHAM of Camden Co., Ga. b. 1806 "Ga." m. 1824 Mary Norton (b. SC 1813. Camden Co. lines say from Beaufort, connection not yet clarified.

Probably other Ishams, but I cannot hunt them now. Had above listed.ABP.



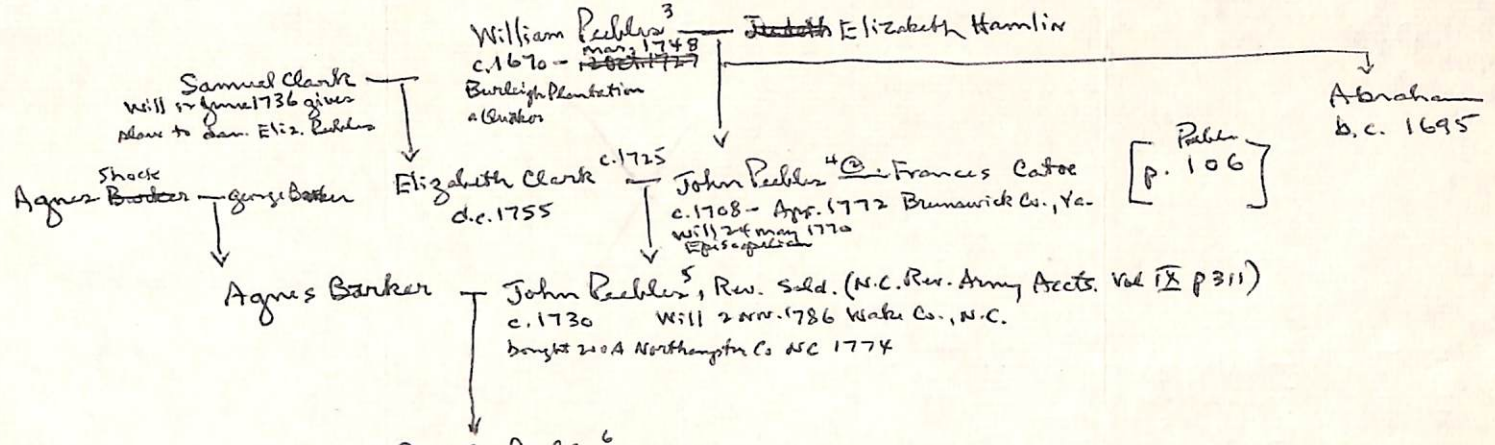

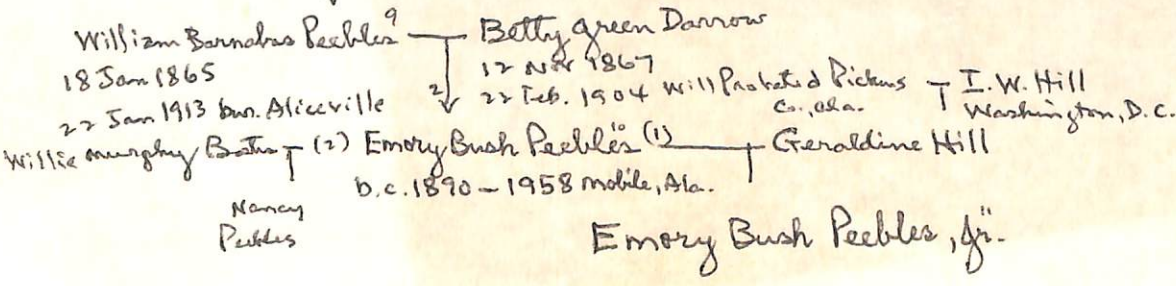
