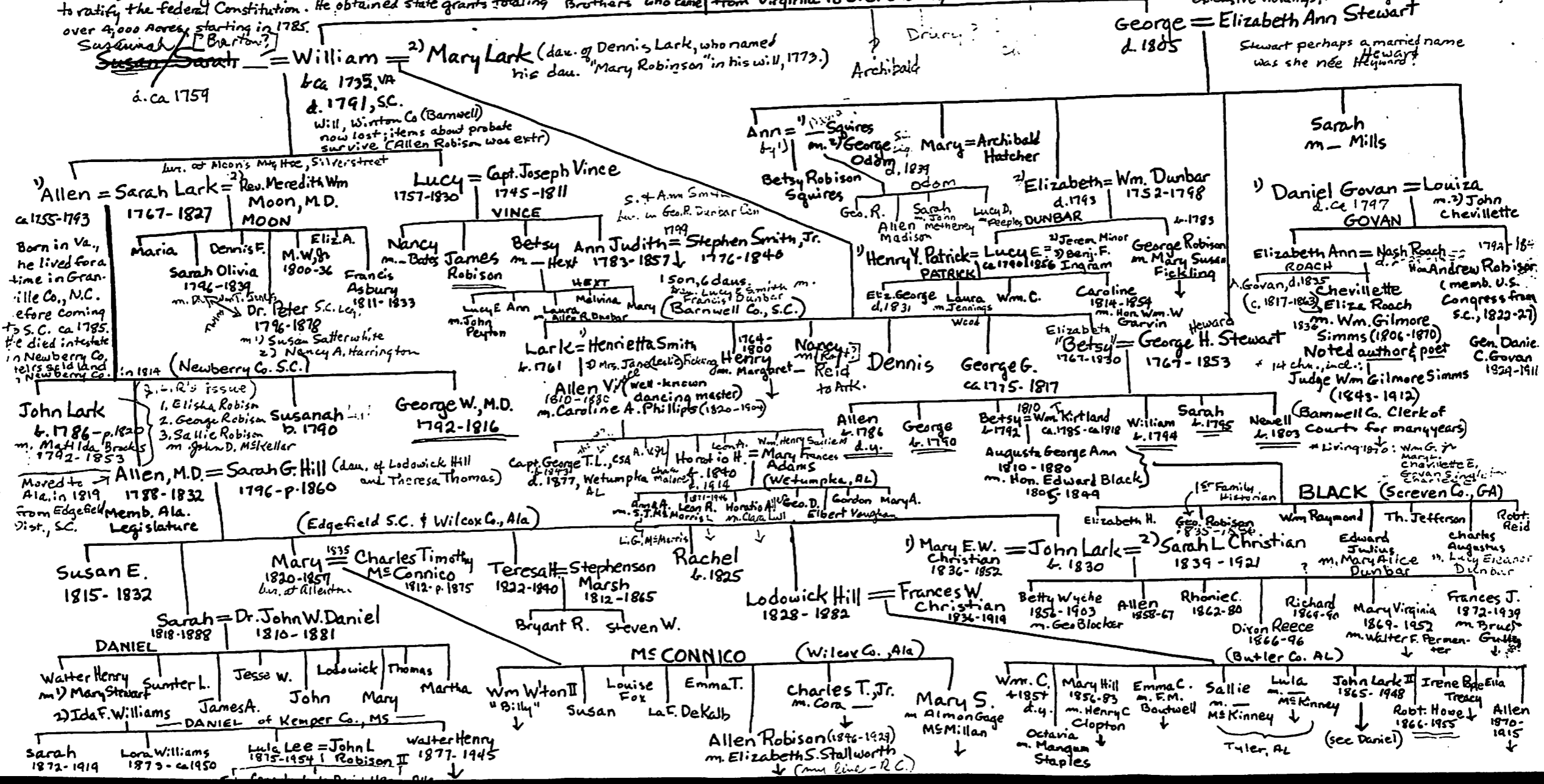


# ROBISON

William Robison "son and heir at law of George Robison, dec'd" deeded land to John Maclin of Brunswick Co., 7 Dec 1756. (land had been mortgaged by George 24 Sept 1754, but not redeemed by the due date of 20 July 1755) There are many deeds in Lunenburg/Mecklenburg records until 1774. His wife in 1758 was Susanah; after 1763 his wife is always Mary. By 1778 he had bought land in Orangeburg Dist., S.C. (later Barwell) and was named on jury and tax lists. He was a Sargt. during the Revolution, and was elected to the General Assembly four times (1782-88). As a delegate to the S.C. state convention (1788) he voted to ratify the federal Constitution. He obtained state grants totaling over 4,000 acres, starting in 1785.

George Robison (b. ca 1710) d. ca. 1755(?)  
 "said to be" Brothers who came from Virginia to S.C. shortly before the Revolution

George Robison in S.C. by 1769 (1st land grant) A militia captain, he was also a delegate to the S.C. Provincial Congresses and the later General Assemblies. He received grants of 1,171 acres by 1787. His will indicates extensive holdings, including 33 slaves.

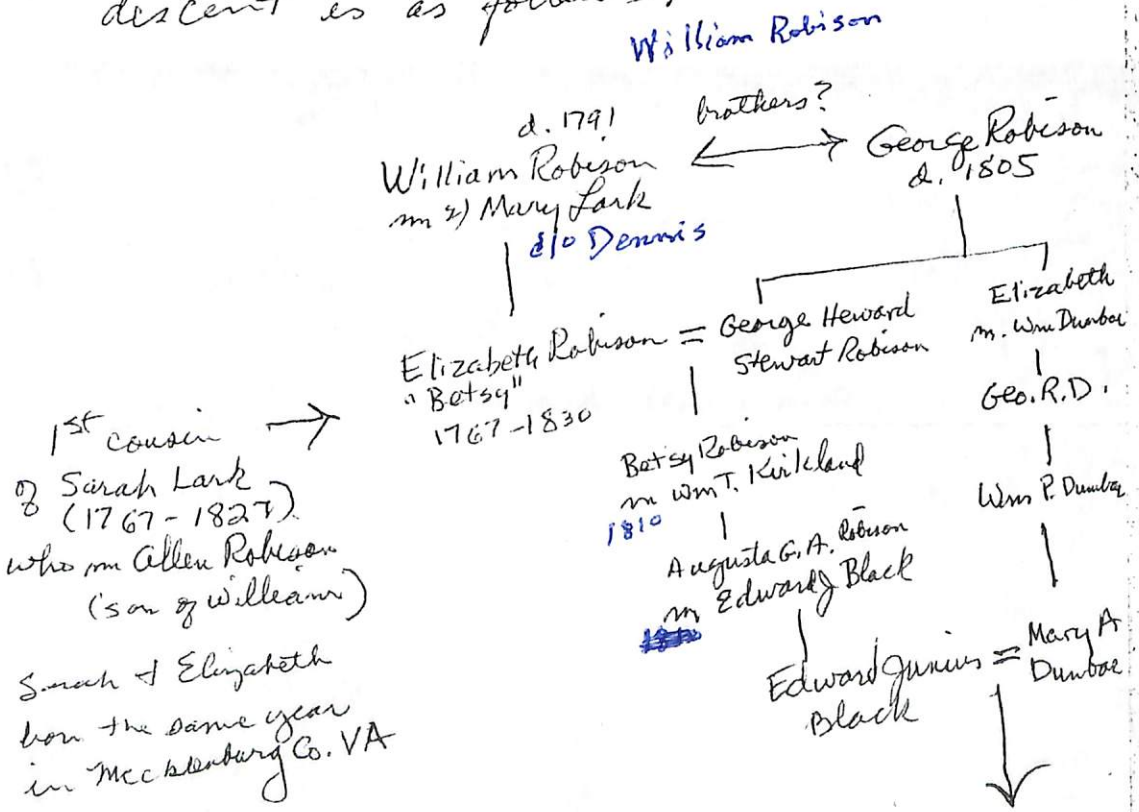
