**Boat Pieces Are
Found on Ararat**

LONDON (AP) — A team of American archaeologists looking for the remains of Noah's Ark reported Friday several pieces of wood, apparently part of a huge boat, have been found 14,000 feet up the slopes of Mount Ararat in eastern Turkey. George Vandeman, chairman of the American-based Archaeological Research Foundation, told a news conference here he hoped to know for certain within three years whether or not the ark is on the mountain. Vandeman said the pieces of wood fitted in with research through the years. The evidence suggested they came from a boat about two-thirds the size of the British Cunard liner Queen Mary. The Queen Mary is 1,019 feet long, 118 feet wide. In 1855, said Vandeman, another piece of wood, seven feet long, was found in an ice pack in the same area. It was estimated to date from around 2,500 B.C.
