Some more genealogical questions! I understand you descend from Jacob Copeland 1776 - 3 hrs. 1853 & his wife Mary Riser? 1781-1860 of Barnwell District. Do you have proof she was a Riser? I found in Barnwell Court House a Frederick Shubert d. 1832, wife Catherine d. 1834 estate appraised at \$12, 200 incl. 23 slaves. Heirs:
