

NOTE TO VIRGINIA: Please check your mother's Harter Family Bible and let me know the birth, marriage, and death dates of JOHN A. and REBECCA MOLE LIGHTSEY. Is their place of burial given? Their dates in the Harter Family History are slightly different from those given me by Miss Julia Youmans.

NOTE TO JULIA: What is the source of your JOHN A. and REBECCA MOLE LIGHTSEY information? By the way, I'm still working on JOHN FREDERICK LIGHTSEY who married TARISA/THERESA KINARD to learn whether she is the daughter of Michael and Miley Platts Kinard of Lexington County or the sister of Michael Kinard. I'll let you know when I learn something further.

NOTE TO HELON: Please check for a deed from the VARN heirs to DAVID RIVERS referred to in the second paragraph above. I don't have any documentation on it, just the note on page 20 in the Miley book. Also, please check for the estate papers on JOHN BLITCHENDON, who died in 1803, leaving land on Half Moon Bay (Will Book A, p. 58. Source, Joyce S. O'Bannon, "Disappearing Place Names in Barnwell County," Names in South Carolina, Fall 1971, p. 45).

\* Also in 1824, JOHN PLATTS had a survey run on 192 acres on Cowpen Branch and Half Moon Bay (Plat Book 7, p. 210) on the District Line. Where is this? Who owned adjoining land? How did they get it? When and from whom?
