Also from the copies, David Farnum, Sr. is the son of Humphrey Moore and Mary Boatright. I am sending a copy of it to you, as you may want it for records of your own, or know of someone who is also looking for them. Do you have any connections on the Boatright family?

I'm sure I don't remember all of what I read on the three Christian names. Can I assume then, that a surname in Harriett's past was Salome, Revice. What do these combination of names tell you?

There's also that note about Susannah Mole Platts. It says she had nine children. Rose Marie Williams only shows her with eight children. She's missing a daughter.

Robert, do you have any other actual photo copies of Bibles that tie into my line anywhere? Besides my grandmothers and my mothers, it's the only one I have found. If you do, I will be happy to reimburse duplication costs.

I know you must have heard about Uncle James. He is SCHE, but still with us. I den't have anyone to ask little questions of, like where is the Gray cemetery? I really think he had a premonition. I saw him last about two weeks before he died. Just before I left, he asked me to get your permission in writing to use the information you have given us for our own little family history. He told me he wanted me to finish his Clifton family for him because he wanted it published for his children and grands. Now, I don't know what to say. I've talked to his daughters. They know how important it was to him.

I hope they at least either type up his records, or give them to me and I'll type them up. I suppose it would be the proper thing to do to give the historical society a copy for records. It's all hand written. I hope they do the right thing.

Well, if in the future I should want to publish anything for my children, may I have your permission to use the information you've given me? I know, you're rolling over laughing, right? I am still learning a great deal, little by little. But, I'm getting there. Of course I don't know the history and things to put with it, but maybe by the time I'm 45 I'll have acquired a little wisdom. When my children can be left unattended, I'll have time for meetings. Until then, I'm happy being a mother.

Well, look over these for me please, and tell me what you think. I suppose with this Bible record, all I need now is John Platts Jr. & Susannah's, then Anna's for proof for the DAR. Wish David Williams would start back working on his end. I don't think he's done much. If he has, he hasn't given me any of it.
