POPE GENEALOGY

Thomas Pope (1), came from Virginia about 1690. Settled in Parish of St. John, near Charleston, S.C. Name of wife, unknown. Had issue:
George Pope (2) Thomas(1), was born in St. Johns Parish between 1690 & 1700. He wed 1716, Sarah Humphries of S.C., Church records show birth of two sons; George, Never wed; and JAMES (3) and a daughter Sarah Pope who married Joseph Scott; b. ch. Catherine (1748) George (1751) Joseph (1754) Wm (1757) James (1759) Elizabeth (1768)
James Pope (3) George(2)Thomas(1), born St. Johns parish 1720. He was married August 28, 1755 to Susanna Wells, by Reverend William Peasley. (St Helena's Church record.) She was Baptized in this Church, February 1, 1765/6. He was a member of the Church of England, and a man of great heart and wealth. He died 1764. Had issue:

1. James, born Sept. 14, 1756. (had three children.)*
2. John, born 1758. Married Elizabeth Theus, (daughter of Simeon Theus⁽²⁾ & wife Eliza Mackay, both of S.C.) John, a Major, AM. Revolution. Serving during entire war.**
3. William Pope (4) James(3) George(2) Thomas(1), born 1760.
4. Joseph, born Feb. 22, 1764, married Sarah Jenkins.

^{Capt.} WILLIAM POPE (4) born in S.C. 1760, Died in S.C. 1823. He was always known as Capt. Pope. He married about 1781, #1^{Mar} Sarah (Green) Tucker [of Virginia], but living in ST. Luke's Parish, S.C., at that time. (a daughter of Samuel^{and Sarah} Green). He married #2 Sarah Scott (daughter of Joseph James Scott & wife Katherine Adams).
^{25 Jan 1798} William Pope was a Revolutionary Soldier, and was one of Marion's Men, and is mentioned in history as a gallant young soldier. Ref. Gardner's Anec. of the Rev., Harvey's Lists of S.S.C. Soldiers N.C., -D.A.R. 568; 638; 123034.

WILLIAM POPE (4) Issue by (2) Sarah Scott: a- Sarah, who wed (1) James Snowden. Wed (2) Major George Logan; b--James, wed Elizabeth Scott (daughter of Joseph Adams Scott). Wed (2) Charlotte Lamont; c--George died unmarried; d--Martha, wed Dr. Alexander Verdier; e--Catherine married Rev. Peter Van Pelt of Philadelphia, Pa (Rector of St. Luke's Ch.) f--Franklin P. married Mary Elizabeth (daughter of Joseph James Pope & Sarah Jenkins).
g- Richard R. Pope, wed Martha Julia (daughter of Dr. John Scott); h-- Joseph Adams Pope, never married.

^{Squire} WILLIAM POPE (5) (William 4- James 3- George 2- Thomas 1) of Hilton Head Island, S.C. was born in S.C. in 1788. Member of Episcopal Church; Representative from St. Luke's Parish in Legislature for many years; and also a State Senator. A planter, refugee with his family to Georgia during the War between the States, and died there 3/10/1862
William Pope 5 married (1) Ann Scott (daughter of Joseph James & Katherine Adams Scott)

- WILLIAM POPE (5) married (2) 1816, Sarah Lavinia Pope (5) his first cousin (daughter of his Uncle John Pope (4) & Elizabeth Theus (3)). Sarah Lavinia Pope born 1793.
Issue: One child.

ELIZABETH CATHERINE POPE (6) (William 5, William 4, James 3, George 2, Thomas 1) Born at St. Helena's Island, S.C., March 2, 1818. Married Feb. 1, 1841, Rev. Alsop Parke Vail Woodward. Rev. Woodward, graduated at Union College, N.Y. He was a Clergyman in the Episcopal Church. Also graduated from Princeton, dividing first honors with William Seward, Lincoln's Secretary of State. He was a son of Hezekiah Woodward and Eleanor Vail (granddaughter of Col. Nicholas Stillwell). He died at Daufuskie Island, S.C. November 1858. Elizabeth C. (Pope) Woodward, died in Atlanta, Georgia, May 29, 1904. During the War between the States, she, with her father & MOTHER ^{MOTHER} William Pope (5) and her children refugeed to Milledgeville, Georgia, when informed her home would be burned that noon. An old family Bible was carried off by the Federal soldiers; everything was taken, that wasn't burned. The Negroes said the soldiers cut the portraits from the frames, rolled them up carefully and took with them.

- 4- Alsop Parke, 5/4/1848. Married Catherine Schley Howell (daughter of Clark Howell & Mary Davis Hook), both died in Atlanta, Ga;
- 5- James Fripp, B. 11/10/1849. Wed Ida L. Erwin, (daughter of Dr. William R. Erwin & Julia Caroline Robert of S.C.);
- 6- Elizabeth Catherine, 10/2/1851. Married Robert W. Westmoreland;
- 7- Thomas Drayton, July 1853, died young;
- 8- Sarah Lavinia, born 7/11/1854. Married George H. Guerard of Beaufort, S.C;
- 9- John Edward, 9/11/1856 - 8/15/1937. Wed ¹⁸⁸² Mary Adams Mellichamp of ^{Bluffton} South Carolina.

**John Pope (4) James 3 George 2 Thomas 1), born S.C. 1758, Married Elizabeth Theus (daughter Of Simeon Theus 2, Simeon 1, and Elizabeth Mackay, both of S.C.) John; was a Revolutionary Soldier, and served during the entire war. He held the rank of Major. (S.C. History) He resided in Charleston, S.C. previous to his marriage and was a member of the Episcopal Church. His wife was a member of the Baptist Church. His wife survived him. Issue:

1- Theodosia, married John Frampton, a Planter of Prince William Parish.

2- Elizabeth Susan, married WM. Davis, planter of Prince William Parish.

3- Mary, died young.

4- Sarah Lavinia - married William Pope (5).

5- Elizabeth Catherine, Twin of Sarah L. (this found by EKS)
