

This is copy of a sketch done by Madame Murray
mother of Miss Ellen Murray, not long after
Civil War of the last home of John Jeremiah
Theus Pope on St Helena Island. D.C. It
was called "The Oaks." Is still standing on St.
Helena Island on the right, just as you cross
the bridge from Ladies Island. The great
Storm of 1893 tore off the double porches and
they were not replaced. The trim under the eaves
is only fine feature of house left in 1964. after many
repairs and many stops. John Jeremiah Theus Pope
had given his plantation house "Felicianna" to his
son Daniel Pope and built this smaller home for
his old age - just a few years before Civil War.

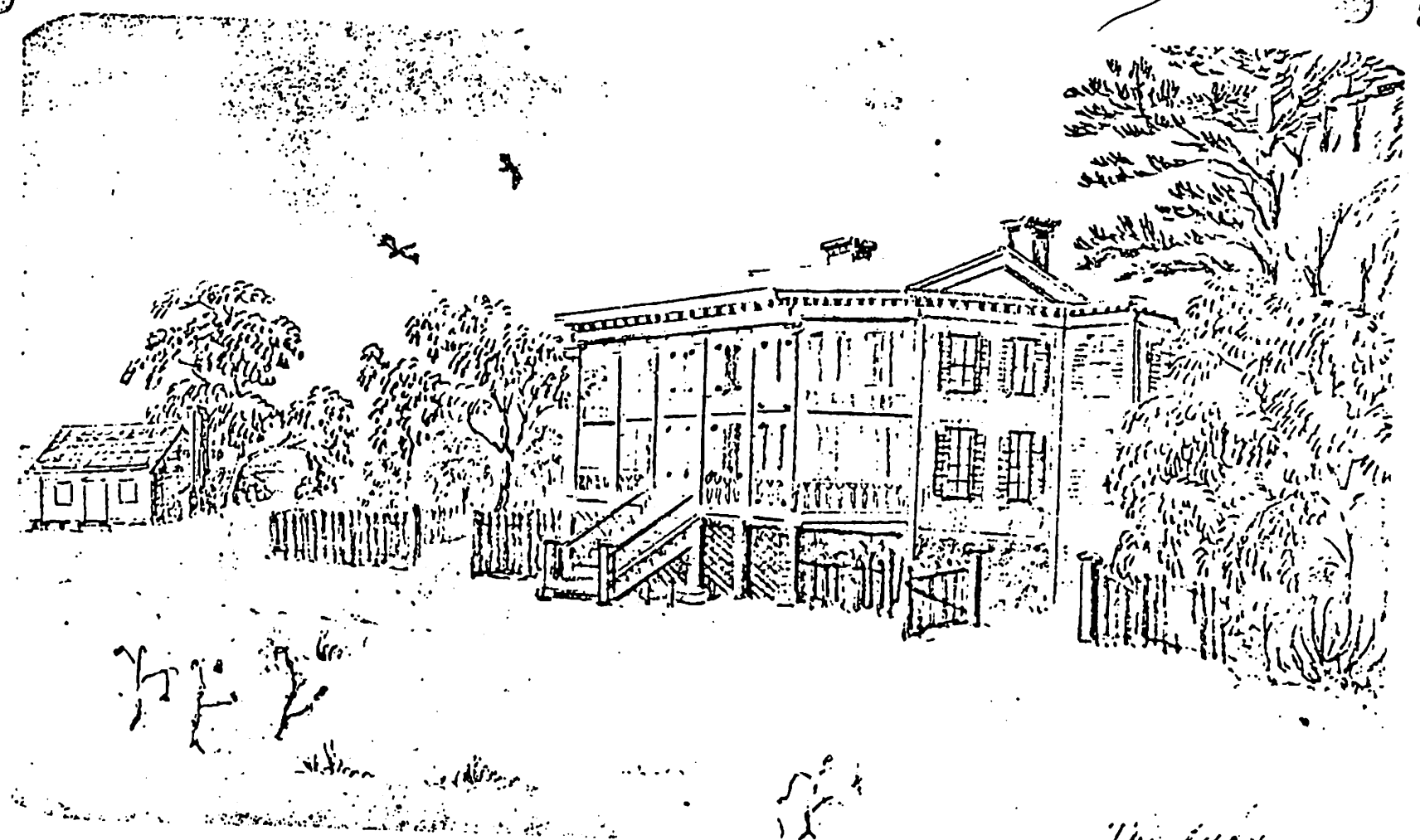
