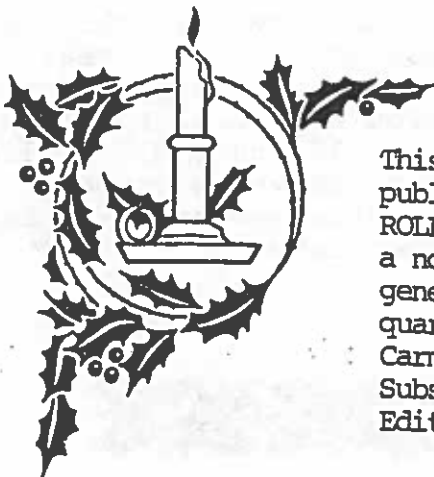

We received a late night telephone call from one of our subscribers RICHARD RAWLINS, descendant of the JAMES RAWLINS/ROLLINS who came to what is now New Hampshire in the 1630's. He has been in correspondence with a JAMES RAWLINS a lawyer/solicitor in England, whose ancestor was a JEAN/JOHN RAULINS, a Huguenot, who with others fled first to England then to the New World in the 1670-80 period. RICHARD thought we would be interested in that, especially since J.R.ROLLINS in his book on the RAWLINS/ROLLINS line in New England (1874) mentions the Huguenot school-teacher in the 1700's.in Massachusetts.

RICHARD's correspondent also told him that JAMES of New Hampshire was born in North Wooten, which is a village found on an 1800's map of Dorset County in England near Shelbourne, which was part of the estate of the Duke of Cleveland. JAMES and his wife Hannah were married near there since she was born in Weymouth. She may have been the widow of a brother or a cousin of JAMES, either THOMAS or WILLIAM.

RICHARD has promised more info on this new find. We look forward to it.

BENJAMIN W. RAWLINS Jr., chairman and chief executive of the Union Planters Corporation, died Tuesday of a heart attack at his home in Memphis, TN. He was 62.

Mr.Rawlins served as chief executive for more than 16 years, and under his leadership the company grew from a \$2 billion Memphis bank to a 12-state \$34 billion financial services company. Funeral arrangements will be announced later.

Before me, D. Gilleland, Esq. , Register for the probate of wills and granting letters of administration in and for said county, personally appeared Henry Kennedy, who on his solemn oath did depose and say that on the 4th day of December 1841, he did put up six copies of the foregoing notices, at six public places in the county, to give notice to all persons interested therein; one at the Monongahela Bridge, one at the corner of Fourth & Grant Streets, one at the corner of Demona (sp) Alley and Grant Street, one at the office in the front of the New Courthouse, one at the Old Courthouse, and one at Daniel Haugheys on Liberty Street...and that the said copies were duly fastened in conspicuous situations.

Signed and sworn and subscribed by Henry Kennedy, before me, this 9th day of December, 1841.

A further note states that as of January 3, 1842, the Administration, etc. of ANTHONY W. ROLLINS' estate was confirmed NISI by the Circuit Judge C. L. Millican

There is a two-page list of items and bills paid by the Administrator to various persons, one is interesting in that Funeral Expenses were paid out of this estate for a HENRY ROLLINS. Other ROLLINS names were R.R. ROLLINS and JOHN W. ROLLINS, no relationship stated.

A HENRY ROLLINS, his wife and family, along with 4 brothers, came to Pennsylvania from what is now Northern Ireland, in the 1760's, it is believed. HENRY's brothers were JAMES, ANTHONY, GEORGE and BENJAMIN. GEORGE & BENJAMIN seemed to have disappeared but HENRY, JAMES and ANTHONY remained in Pennsylvania, the latter two settling in Westmoreland and HENRY in Washington County. JAMES was killed by a falling tree but ANTHONY lived to a great age, but both had no children. HENRY had 7 children; SARAH, JOHN, MARY, SAMUEL, JANE, JAMES and ANTHONY. The ANTHONY mentioned above was HENRY's brother. JOHN, JAMES and ANTHONY, the sons of HENRY, went to Transylvania University in Kentucky. JAMES and ANTHONY became lawyers, and JOHN became a doctor.

From a copy of a 1903 Application for a widow's pension by REBECCA H. (RAWLINGS) Gibbs, wife of Joseph F. Gibbs, Confederate Soldier. It was filled out by her April 18, 1903, and finally approved March 28, 1904. In it she states that Joseph died December 20, 1891, chronic rheumatism contracted during service in the War Between the States, which attacked his heart at the time of death. His middle name was Freeman. She stated she was living with her youngest daughter, M.V. Browder, in

Brunswick Co., Virginia. REBECCA was to receive \$25.00 annually. She also gives her marriage date as January 10, 1848, although the Marriage Register for Brunswick Co. (Reel 47 at LVA) shows 1849.

REBECCA and her ancestors can be found in the five-part coverage of Brunswick Co. RAWLINGS in the June, September and December 1993...and March and June issues in 1994 newsletters.

On-line through an Ancestry.com paid subscription, Jean found an actual handwritten copy of the 1850 Federal Census for Shelby County, Tennessee (Memphis)-8958, p.75 written on September 11, 1850.

JOHN HUTCHINGS RAWLINGS, a brickmaker, age 43, property worth \$11,000. His wife Sara is 36; daughter Lydia, 16; son JAMES, 14; dtr. RACHEL, 12; son STOKELY, 10; RICHARD JACKSON, 6; dtr. JANE, 3; son JOHN, 1 day old. The mother-in-law, Lydia Hayes, is 65 and was born in Virginia. All the remainder of the family were born in Tennessee. RICHARD JACKSON RAWLINGS is Jean's ancestor. He was in the Civil War. His brother STOKELY was killed in that war. JOHN HUTCHINGS RAWLINGS, their father, died at the age of 52 on July 5, 1859...and his wife SARA died October 16, 1860 at the age of 46.

Jean also found J.H. RAWLINGS' mother, Rachel Donelson Hutchings RAWLINGS, in the Tennessee 1830 census in Madison County.

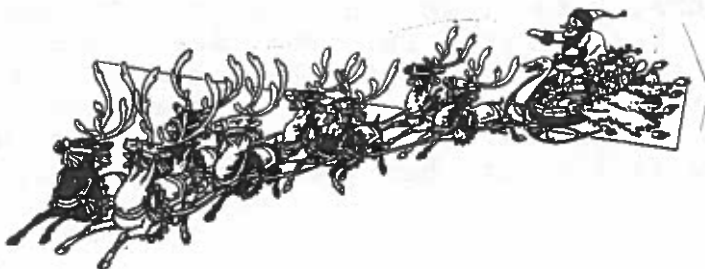

The following research has been gathered by Steve and Colleen over a period of time, and with the help of many resources within and from outside her family.

JAMES RAWLINS first appears travelling with a party of settlers coming to Ohio 1800-1801, a young man in his twenties. One member of the party was Shadrack Ruark along with several sons, Arthur, James, John, Shadrack Jr and perhaps others. He also had several daughters, among them ELIZABETH who married JAMES RAWLINS, no date available. After stopping in several stops they finally homesteaded in what was then known as Geauga County, but which later was Lake County.

Since we are concentrating on the direct line from JAMES to Colleen we will deal only with JAMES and ELIZABETH's descendants and not follow the RUARK line.



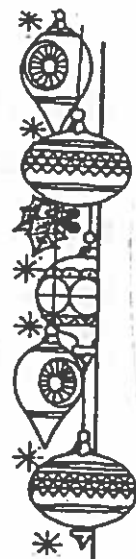

Another of our subscribers has finished their tribute to their ancestors and his/her descendants. This time it's Carolyn Bowen Thurber, of Maryland...and it delineates her line from JOSEPH LEVIN RAWLINGS b. ca 1785, Calvert Co., Maryland...deceased ca 1845. Here is a brief summary found at the beginning of the book to set time and place.

"According to census records, LEVIN RAWLINGS was born between 1780 and 1790. He was married and living in Calvert County, Maryland by 1820. He was a farmer and had one slave, a young boy under 14 years of age. His wife was Barbara J. Cantor who was born about 1799. She was unable to read or write. LEVIN died before 1850; Barbara died Aug. 2, 1854.

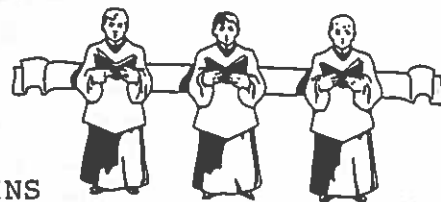

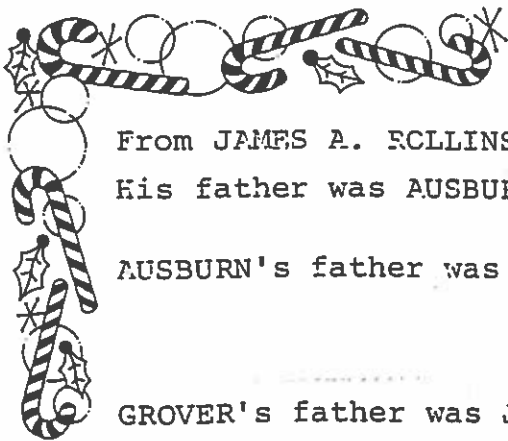

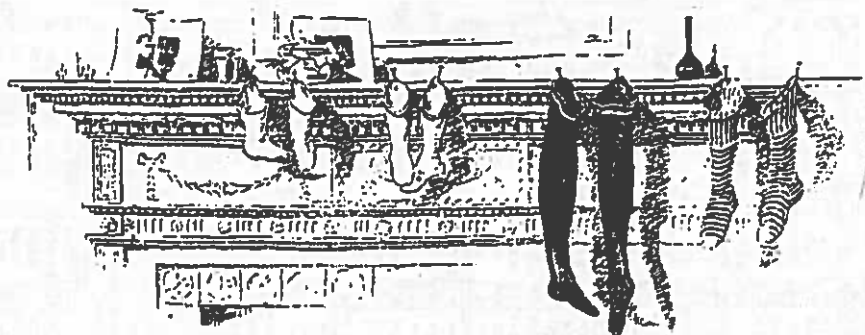
