Have a question or two for you on our Reynolds-Chaplin lines. Quite by accident I have "stumbled" onto a descendant of Lavinia Chaplin Oswald Duncan! Am so happy about this for I have long wanted contact with some of her descendants and those of her twin sister, Cecilia Oswald — and

somewhere (?) There must be some descendants of their brother, Benjamin S. Chaplin, who separated from his wife and went West, returning occasionally to see his children! Do you have the names of his wife and their children? Do you know, or know of, descendants of Lavinia and Cecilia and how I might contact some of them?

I'm trying to help the Reynolds cousins in Alabama either find documentation or further family traditional evidence that there was a Martha Sarah Reynolds, daughter of William and Jane, who was the wife of Benjamin Chaplin, Jr. and the mother of Lavinia, Cecilia, Martha Sarah and Benjamin S. - and two other daughters who must have died young for Ch. S. was their fifth daughter. He surely will appreciate it if you

can help us with this. They  
seem to be working hard to  
document or have strong evidence  
for all they are saying and I  
greatly appreciate that - and  
know that we'll all be glad to  
have their book. Have just ac-  
quired the Leppers book and am  
now waiting on the supplement  
to that which, I understand, will  
have some interesting corrections  
and additons in it.
