So far as I can discover there has been no work done locally on the Rhodes family. The only reference to John Rhodes in our collection is in a conveyance of 514 acres of land on Port Royal Island, dated July 6, 1785. It shows that Richard Talbird of Granville County. Henry and Thomas Talbird of Hilton County in Beaufort District. and John Rhodes, merchant of Charleston, all executors of Henry Talbird deceased, sold the property to Thomas Talbird of Granville County. The document has the signature of John Rhodes.

If you wish to put your problem in the hands of a professional genealogist (for the staff of the Society does not have the time to undertake individual research) I would suggest that you consult any one of the ladies named below.
