Dear Mr. Rhodes

My Sister-in-law May Jo Lieberood of Mt Pleasant sent me your letter asking about ^{Samuel K. Lieberood (1861-1893)} Samuel Lieberood. He was my Great uncle but I can't tell you a lot about him. I began last year trying to do a little checking into my family, but have not had time recently to pursue it. Here what I know

Samuel was born in New York in 1861 and died in ^{Julia M. Brown (d/o Wm & Virginia (Rhodes) Brown)} Charleston in 1893. He was married to Julia but I do not have any information on her. Samuel had 2 brothers ?? Charles W 1853-1887 and my Grandfather George E (1888-1903). As best I can determine their father was Charles and apparently was married twice. The 3 boys were born in New York but he married again to Julia E and they had 3 children. I did find both Samuel's death notice and Julia in the News + Courier in Charleston. I'm enclosing the photo copy that I have for you use. The Charleston directory beginning in 1895 shows Julia working at the W.E. & C. Co and lived at 20 Bogard St. 1898 at 2 Percy St. 1899 104 Shepard St. and 1901 forelady sewing Dept W.E. & C. Co 20 Percy St. and in 1903 at 86 May St. Her date of death was Apr 23, 1903.

I hope this will help. If I find other information as I search again I'll send it to you
