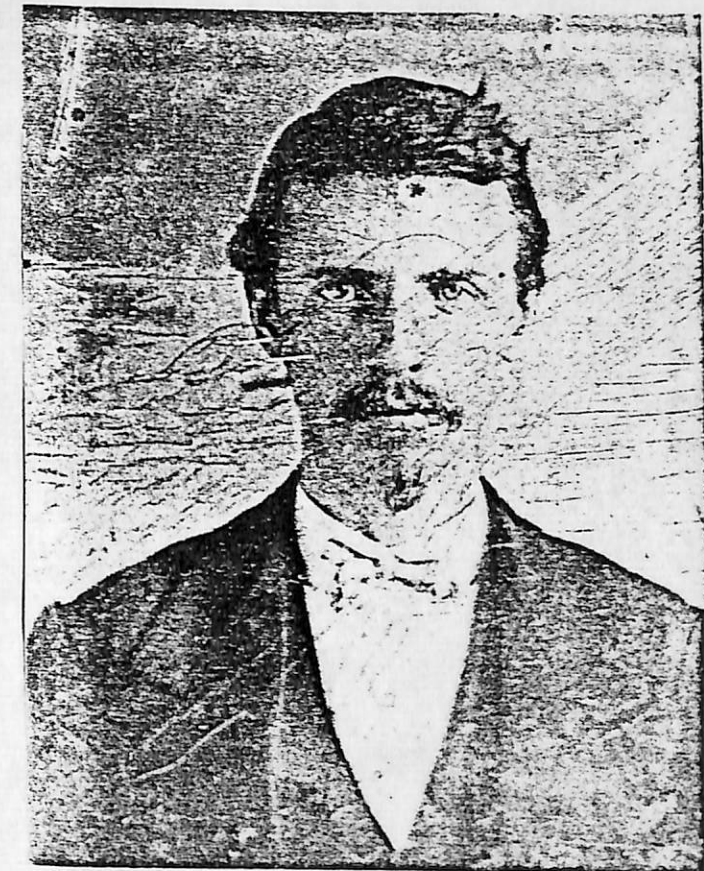

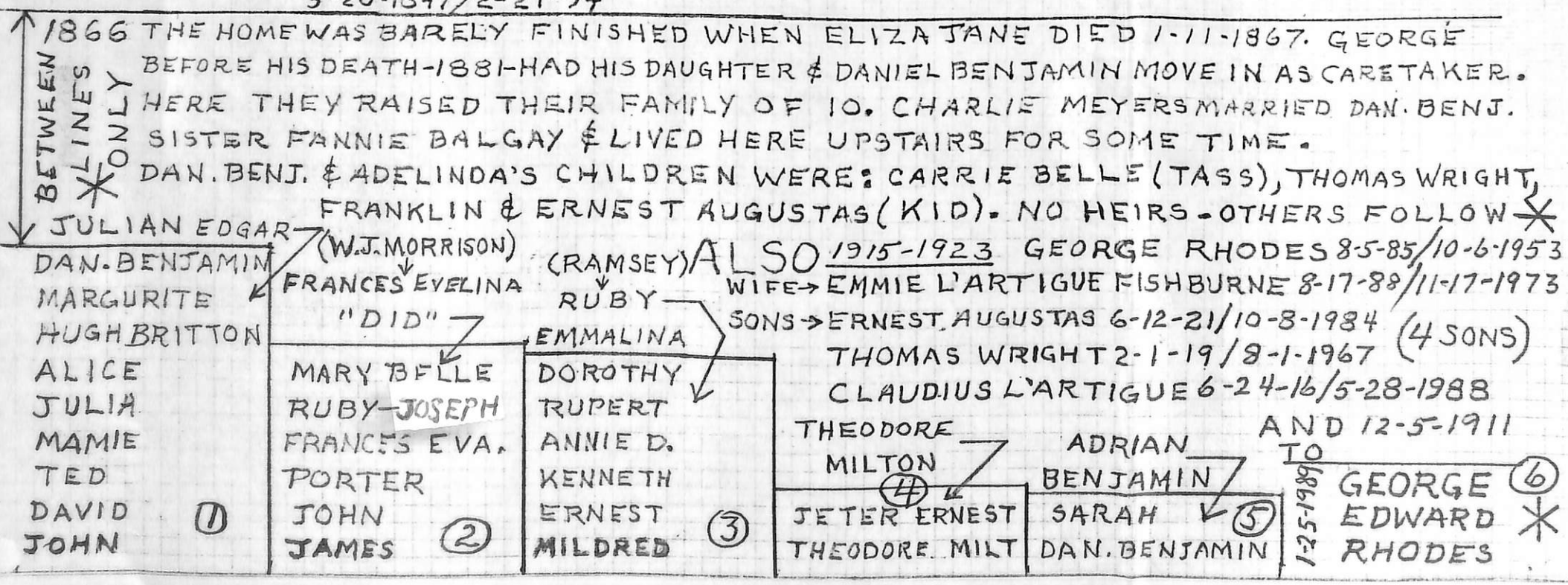
Thomas Rhodes married twice:

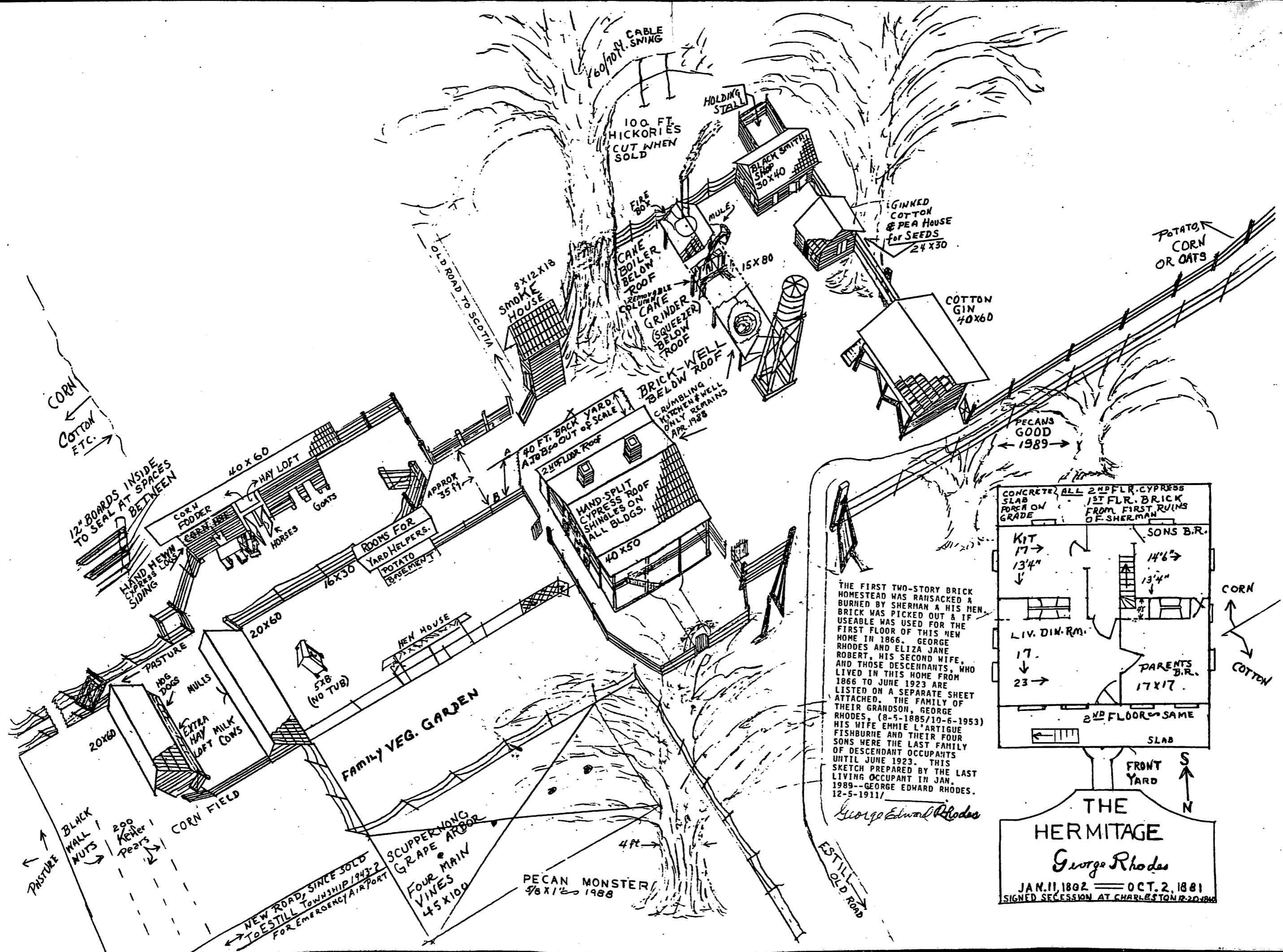
The second wife was Mary Elizabeth Cater.

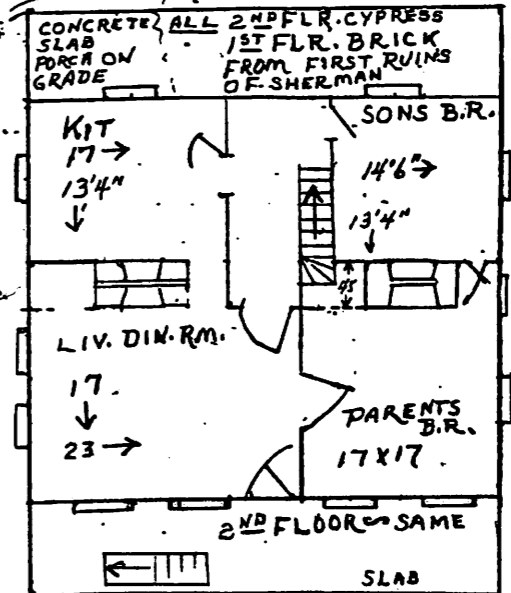

THE FIRST TWO-STORY BRICK HOMESTEAD WAS RANSACKED & BURNED BY SHERMAN & HIS MEN. BRICK WAS PICKED OUT & IF USEABLE WAS USED FOR THE FIRST FLOOR OF THIS NEW HOME IN 1866. GEORGE RHODES AND ELIZA JANE ROBERT, HIS SECOND WIFE, AND THOSE DESCENDANTS, WHO LIVED IN THIS HOME FROM 1866 TO JUNE 1923 ARE LISTED ON A SEPARATE SHEET ATTACHED. THE FAMILY OF THEIR GRANDSON, GEORGE RHODES, (8-5-1885/10-6-1953) HIS WIFE EMHIE L'ARTIGUE FISHBURNE AND THEIR FOUR SONS WERE THE LAST FAMILY OF DESCENDANT OCCUPANTS UNTIL JUNE 1923.
