

Thomas Rhodes, born Bridgnorth, Shropshire, Eng. 22 April 1775, son of George Rhodes and Elizabeth ("Betsy") Baché who were married 11 Nov. 1772 at the Church of St. Mary Magdalene, Bridgnorth; baptized 14 May 1775; immigrated to South Carolina after 1790 and married (1) 10 July 1795 in St. Philip's Church, Charleston, Mary Wright, daughter of the late John Wright of Charleston; two children:

Thomas Rhodes married (2) Mary Elizabeth Cater (25 June 1776 - 25 Feb. 1823), daughter of ^{Rev. War.} Capt. Thomas Cater (17 Dec. 1751 - 20 Apr. 1805) ^{planter} of Cater Hall Plantation, St. Peter's Parish, and Rachel Miles (1755-1802), daughter of Capt. Silas Miles of Poplar Springs Plantation, St. Paul's Parish and Elizabeth, daughter of Capt. James McPherson (1688 - 6 Mar. 1771) of the S.C. Rangers. Thomas Rhodes died at his Calliwassi Island Plantation 25 April 1809, leaving three children by Mary Elizabeth Cater who in 1810 married Winborn Asa Lawton and is buried in the Robert Cemetery near Robertville:

Thomas Rhodes took the Oath of Naturalization and became an American citizen 23 Jan. 1808 (SCTM 66 p 221). The 1800 Federal Census shows Thomas Rhodes owning 20 slaves in St. Peter's Parish. The 1810 Census shows Mrs. Mary Cater Rhodes owning 28 slaves in St. Peter's Parish.

Thomas Wright Rhodes, ^{sc.} born 6 May 1796, died at Walterboro November 1862, buried at Sheldon; married Elizabeth Phoebe Jenkins (20 Jan. 1798 - died at Beaufort 1854, buried at Lands End Plantation, St. Helena's Island), daughter of Col. John Jenkins and Sarah Phoebe Chaplin, born 24 May 1778, daughter of Thomas Chaplin and Elizabeth Fripp; 8 children:

His father died when he was only ten years old and his mother died five years later; he was sent

to live with his uncle George Rhodes and later clerked for his cousin John Jenkins Rhodes at Lawtonville, whence he went to his aunt, Mrs. Ulysses Maner Robert (Rachel Cater Rhodes) in Georgia and was employed as a salesman for Myers & Brothers, Albany, Ga.; he returned to Colleton Co. where he married and lived until 1876 when he moved to Screven Co., Ga. near his brother.
