JULY 10, 1795, THOMAS RHODES AND MARY WRIGHT, SPINSTER WERE MARRIED PER LICENSE BY REV. THOMAS FROST.
IN ANOTHER PLACE IT STATES THAT THOMAS RHODES MARRIED MARY WRIGHT, DAUGHTER OF JOHN WRIGHT IN JUNE, 1795, KEATING SIMMONS, TRUSTEE, ELIZABETH WRIGHT, EDWARD SIMMS, WITNESSES. NOTE: THIS WAS THE FIRST WIFE OF THOMAS RHODES. MOST OF THOMAS RHODES DESCENDANTS, INCLUDING THE GEORGIA SIDE, WERE DESCENDED FROM HIS SECOND WIFE, MARY CATER. HIS SON THOMAS BY HIS FIRST WIFE HAD THREE SONS THAT MARRIED DAUGHTERS OF HIS HALF BROTHER, GEORGE RHODES. THEIR DESCENDANTS WOULD BE DESCENDED FROM BOTH OF THOMAS' WIVES

THIS MARY RHODES WAS THE WIDOW OF Dr. N. H. RHODES, FIRST COUSIN TO OUR THOMAS RHODES. HE WAS THE SON OF JOHN RHODES WHO CAME TO S. C. BEFORE THE REVOLUTION. MARY WAS THE DAUGHTER OF PAUL HAMILITON FORMER GOVERNOR OF S. C. AND LATER SECRETARY OF THE NAVY.
