 married Miss Mary Wright. They had two children, ^{May 1796 - Nov 1862} Thomas Wright
 and Sara; his wife died and he married ^(second) Miss Mary ^{Elizabeth} Coler, who had
 three children; George, Nathaniel and Rachel; he died at the age of 32.
 (His widow married Rev. Winborn A. Lawton.) Sara married Mr. Tripp; Thomas

Rosa married James Fickling. They reared ten children, noted
 for their great height.

Daniel Benjamin. married Addie Gertrude Rhodes (his cousin)
 of Lawtonville, South Carolina. They had nine children and she
 died at the age of 48; he never married again. Their daughter,
 Carrie Belle helped him rear the children; six boys and three
 girls: Thomas Wright, Ernest Augustus, Julian Edgar, Theodore
 Milton, George and Adrian, Benjamin, Carrie Belle, Ruby Emma
 and Frances Evelyn (Effie.)

Rachel married Ulysses Robert; Nathaniel married Miss
^{Haygood} Hamilton. George married twice; first, Theresa Evelina Robert,
 daughter of Rev. James John Robert of Robertville, S. C. (and
 Charlotte Anne Lawton, his wife). They had three

children, James Pringle, Mary Charlotte & Sara. Charlotte & Sara both died young. James married Margaret Pauline Lawton of Aulandale, S.C. They had three children: Henry, George and Susan Ella. Henry married Mamie Cooley of Rome, Ga. Their daughter, Clara Lawton teaches at Coher College now. He married a second time and was divorced. George married Miss Julia Baynard. Their oldest daughter, Josephine married Badger Calhoun and died, leaving two children; William Baynard and Corvine. The other daughter, May, married Ernest A. Reeder. They have no children. Susan Ella married Thomas Ellis and had two children: Margaret and George.

George Rhodes' second wife was Eliza Jane Robert, sister of his first wife. She was very young but married him to take care of his children. She had 14 children: George Milton, Thursa ^{John Robert} Euclia, Henrietta Eugenia, Theodore Augustus, Minnie, ^{John Robert} John, Addie Gertrude, Rosalind, Julia Anna Cora, Eliza Jane, Ida Matilda, Phoebe, Joseph ^{Nathaniel} ~~Robert~~ and Thomas Willingham. Eugenia, Joseph and Thomas died in young adulthood. Theodore Augustus was killed in the Battle of Gettysburg. George Milton Rhodes married Mrs. Bryant, widow (Sara Jane Willingham before her marriage). They had seven children: Agnes married Mr. Washington; Benjamin married three times, Louie King, Addie Gamage and Lovie Martin; Cornelia married Rev. J. T. Morrison; Pauline married George B. Clarke; Belle married Joseph S. Morrison; Claude married ^{Allen} Paul Dunbar. George Milton married twice. 8 Aug. 1856 - 29 Apr. 1923

T. Euclia married John Jenkins Rhodes; Minnie married Thos. B. Roberts. They had one daughter Julia May Allen. John Robert Rhodes married Olive Coachman. They had three children: Carrie, Minnie and Allston. Carrie married Mr. Trenholm and died leaving little Ruby. Minnie married Hal Grier and divorced him. Allston is married and has no children. Rosalind married James M. Roberts. She died at the age of about 40, had 12 children, leaving four: Clifford, Lywood, Herman and Henry (who died a few years later).

Juliana Cole married E. B. Stoney. They had 6 children;
Leila, who married W. B. Lawton, Joseph Robert, ^{Samuel} Reed,
Edward (red, who is afflicted), Cornelius and Lenora,
(who married James Morrison.)

Eliza Jane (Lila) married her cousin, John Williamson
Peeples. They had thirteen children: George Theodore,
William Edward, Claude Robert, Benjamin Joseph,
Charlotte Esther, Eliza Jane, Mamie Burns, John

Hon. George Rhodes, His life, his forebears and his Children.

1758
In 1745 John ~~Nathaniel~~ Rhodes landed at ^{Charleston} Port

Royal, South Carolina, with ~~his~~ sister, Henrietta. About thirty-two years later ~~they~~ ^{he was} were joined by their nephew, Thomas Rhodes, ^{from Shropshire, England} at that time probably a young man for soon ^{thereafter} he married Mary Wright. She apparently died soon after the birth of their children, Thomas Wright Rhodes (who married Sarah Phoebe Jenkins and left descendants) and Sara Rhodes (who married ^{her} son, Thomas married as his second

wife, Mary Cater (b. June 25, 1776 - d. Mich. 1823), Their first ^(only of this paper) son was George Rhodes, b. Jan. 11, 1802 at Callawash Island, S. C. * Apparently, his father died some time thereafter and we find young George being educated by his aunt, Mrs. James Pringle, of Charleston, at the school of Dr. Waddell, at Willington. Young George must have been an apt student because soon he was engaged in teaching. On Nov. 15, 1821 George married Thirza Evelina Robert, b. Sept 4, 1803, the daughter of Rev. James Jehu Robert and Charlotte Anne Lawton, his cousin. Although it is an old story to many of you, it may be worthwhile to say something of the forebears of Thirza Evelina's parents. Rev. James Jehu Robert was pastor of the Robertville Baptist Church for 50 years. He was the son of Elizabeth Dixon and John Robert. This John Robert, although a man of means and distinction, served one year in the Continental Army as a private, during the Revolutionary war. He was the great-grandson of Rev. ^{Pastor} Pierre Robert, French Huguenot first French Huguenot minister to preach in South Carolina (who arrived at Santee, S. C. in 1686 with his

wife, Jean Bayer, and son Pierre Robert, Jr. who married Judith de Bordeaux, the daughter of Jacques de Bordeaux, another prominent French Huguenot. ~~The son of Pierre Robert, Jr. + Judith de Bordeaux was~~ Elizabeth Dixon, wife of John Robert, was the granddaughter of the 2nd Landgrave Thomas Smith and his 2nd wife, Mary Hyne. Both the character & possessions of the 1st Landgrave Thos. Smith (Gov. of Carolina, 1693) and his eldest son, the 2nd Landgrave are well known to all students of South Carolina History. Among their descendents are not only the Robert, Lawton and Rhodes families, but also the Balls, Waring, Rhett, Barnwell, Smith, Simons and Lowndes of Charleston, ^{some of} the most noble and aristocratic families of America.

Charlotte Ann Lawton, mother of Thirza Evelina Robert, was the daughter of Joseph Lawton and Sarah Robert, sister to John Robert. Joseph Lawton's father, Captain William Lawton was one of the 21 children of John Lawton of Lawton Hall in Cheshire, England and Anne Montagu, granddaughter of Sir Henry Montagu, Earl of Manchester. With 20 known generations of noble Montagus behind her, including the Earles of Salisbury, Anne Montagu was a member of the House of the Peers of Swacliff. ~~Through the marriage~~ of one of her ^{noble} Montagu ancestors ^{married} Margaret

Mauthemer, daughter of Sir ^{Thomas} Peter Mauthemer and
~~Baron~~ of Acres, second daughter of King Edward I
 of England and Eleonore (daughter of King Ferdinand
 III of Castile. Through this marriage Charlotte Anne
 Lawton was lineally descended from William the
 Conqueror, Alfred the Great, Geoffrey, Duke of Anjou,
 founder of the race of Plantagenets, the Counts
 of Savoy, the Dukes of Burgundy, the Dukes of
 Normandy, the Kings of Leon, Castile, Aragon,
 Navarre and Portugal, Hugh Capet, King of France
 in the 10th Century, the Kings of Lombardy and
 Germany, Scotland and Denmark, many of whom
 we can trace back 35 and 40 generations.

John Lawton's parents were William Lawton and
 Hester Longueville, daughter of Sir Edward Longueville,
 Baronet of Northamptonshire. He was a descendent of the
 Hastings family, the Earls of Huntingdon and his
 family may be traced back some 20 or 25 generations.

The first child of George Rhodes and Theresa Euclina
 Robert was James Pringle Rhodes, b. Dec. 27, 1823. It
 is not the purpose of this article to include the
 ultimate descendants of Hon. George Rhodes, so suffice
 it to say that James Pringle Rhodes married his
 distant cousin, Margaret Polhill Lawton and has
 numerous descendants living. Sarah C. Rhodes
 was born on Jan. 22, 1826 and Mary Charlotte Rhodes
 on April 22, 1828.

Some time soon after the birth of her third child, Thirza, Evelina Robert died. Her father presided at her funeral. George, left with three small children on his hands, appealed to his father-in-law for advice. The Rev. assured him that the only thing to do was to marry his other daughter, Eliza Jane. George did and the following year, his second son, George Rhodes, II was born, Oct. 17, 1829. Sometime before 1830, both of his daughters, Sarah C. and Mary Charlotte Rhodes died.

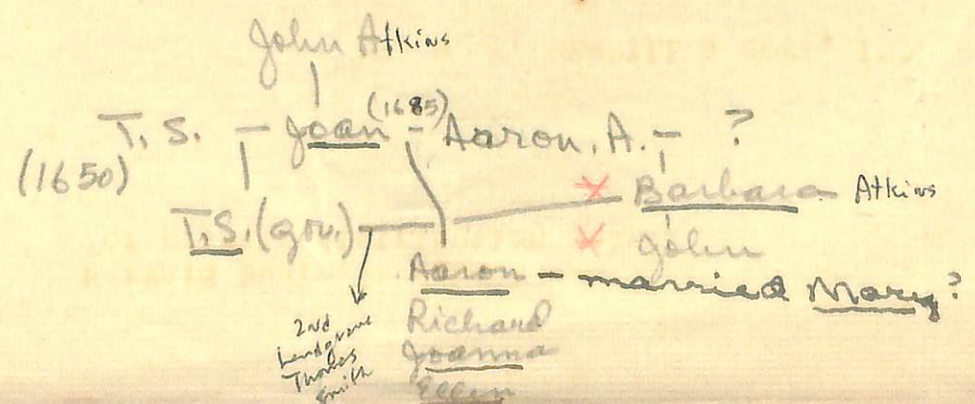

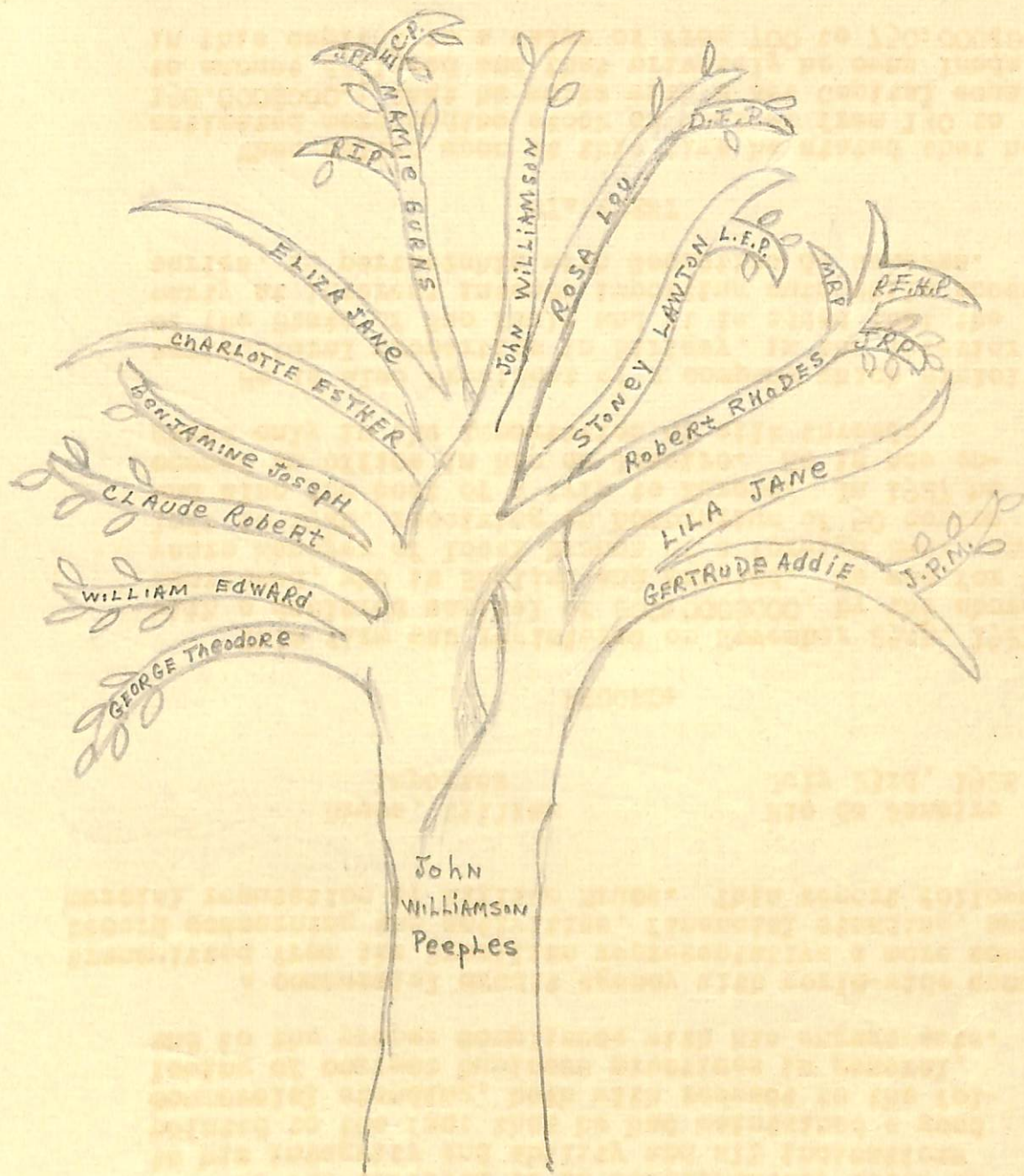
