This is the last Will and Testament of me Thomas Bache of
Bridgnorth in the County of Salop Gentleman as follows I give and Bequeath to
my Nephew Thomas Bache Son of my Brother John Bache and to my Nephew
Samuel Bache youngest Son of my said Brother John and their Assigns during
their respective natural lives one Annuity yearly Rent Charge certain of Five
Pounds apiece of lawful Money of Great Britain to be charged upon issuing and
payable from and out of All those my new erected Mills with the Lands building
and Appurtenances therunto belonging And also out of all that my Homage and
Lands with the Appurtenances situate in the Township and Parish of Worfield in
the County of Salop aforesaid And which said Homage Mills Lands and Tenures
I held by virtue of a Lease granted by the Honourable Sir Thomas Whinmire deceased
for the Term of Sixty nine Years if my Nephews John Bache and the said
Thomas and Samuel Bache Children of my said Brother John Bache or either of them
or and shall so long live And I direct the said Annuities to be paid to my said
Nephews Thomas and Samuel Bache and their Assigns respectively during the
Term of their respective natural lives clear of all Taxes and Deductions whatsoever
by two half yearly payments in the year that is to say the Twenty ninth Day of
September and the Twenty fifth Day of March by equal portions the first payment of
the said respective Annuities to the said Thomas and Samuel Bache to begin and
to be made on the first of the said Days as shall happen next after my Decease
Also I give and Bequeath to my Niece Mary Bache Daughter of my said Brother
John the sum of Fifty Pounds to be paid her at the end of two years next after the
Decease of my Wife Rebecca Bache Also I give and Bequeath to my Nephew
William Bache second son of my said Brother John the sum of Fifty Pounds
to be paid him at the end of three years next after the Decease of my said Wife
Rebecca Bache Also I give and Bequeath unto my Nephews John and William
Bache their Executors and Administrators the sum of Fifty Pounds to be paid to
them within twelve Months next after the Decease of my said Wife Upon Trust first
my said Nephews do and shall pay to my Niece Elizabeth the wife of George
Rhodes of Bridgnorth aforesaid Chymist the Interest of the said sum of Fifty pounds
after the rate of Five pounds per Centum per Annūm for and during the Term of her
natural life for her own sole and separate use and that her receipt alone shall be
a sufficient discharge to my said Trustees for the same notwithstanding her
Coverter and from and immediately after the Decease of my said Niece

Elizabeth Rhodes I direct that my aforesaid Trustees shall pay the aforesaid sum of Fifty pounds together with such Interest as shall be then due for the same to and amongst such of the Children of my said Niece Elizabeth Rhodes as shall be living at the time of her Death share and share alike at their respective Ages of Twenty One Years And in Case my said Niece Elizabeth Rhodes shall happen to die without Issue or leaving Issue and all such Issue shall happen to die before they attain their respective Ages of Twenty One years then I direct that my aforesaid Trustees shall pay the said sum of Fifty pounds together with all such Interest as shall be due for the same to such person and persons and in such Shares and proportion as my said Niece Elizabeth Rhodes whether covert or sole and notwithstanding her Coverture shall by her last Will and Testament or any other writing purporting her last Will and Testament attested by two or more credible Witnesses direct or appoint Also I give and Bequeath to Mary Bache Daughter of my Niece Hannah Bache the sum of Ten pounds Also I give and Bequeath to Elizabeth Sarah and William Bache Children of my late nephew William Bache the sum of Ten pounds apiece and to John Williams Son in Law of my Brother in Law Thomas Bache of the Park the sum of Ten pounds and to John and Thomas two of the Sons of the said John Williams the sum of Ten pounds apiece the said several last above mentioned Legacies to be paid to the said several Legatees respectively at the end of five years next after the decease of my said Wife Rebecca Bache And Whereas I have at the special instance and request and for the only proper debt of my nephew Thomas Bache Son of my Brother in Law Thomas Bache of the Park jointly entered into a Note for the payment of Fifty pounds to Charles Carter of Bridgnorth aforesaid Shoemaker till in case the same shall not be paid by my said Nephew Thomas Bache at the decease of my said Wife then I do hereby Will order and Direct the same to be paid by my Executor herein after named within twelve Months next after the decease of my said Wife Rebecca Bache But my Mind and Will further is and I do hereby declare that in case my said Nephew Thomas Bache shall have satisfied and paid to the said Charles Carter the aforesaid sum of Fifty pounds together with all Interest to grow due for the same and shall deliver up said Note to my Executor then I do hereby give and Bequeath to my said Nephew Thomas Bache the sum of Fifty pounds to be paid him within twelve months next after the decease of my said Wife Rebecca Bache And I do hereby Subject and Charge all my Copyhold or Customary Lands Tenements and Hereditaments herein after devised to and with the payment of all and every the aforesaid Legacies at the times and in manner herein before mentioned And Subject thereto and also Subject to the

Estate for life of my said Wife Rebecca therein I give and Devise unto my said Nephew
John Bache and his Heirs All and every my said Copyhold or Customary Lands and
Hereditaments whatsoever situate at Barcott or elsewhere within the Manor and
Parish of Worfield in the said County of Salop To hold unto and to the use of my said
Nephew John Bache his Heirs and Assigns for ever Also I give Devise and Bequeath
All those my aforesaid now erected Mills with the Lands Buildings and Appurtenances
therunto belonging And also all that my aforesaid Mespuaige and Lands with the
Appurtenances situate in the Township and parish of Worfield aforesaid Subject and
Chargeable with the Amrities of Five pounds a piiece to my said Nephews Thomas
and Samuel Bache unto my aforesaid Nephew John Bache his Executors and
Administrators To hold the said Mills Mespuaige Lands and promises Subject as
aforesaid to my said Nephew John Bache his Executors and Administrators for and
during all the Estate Term and Interest I have therin Also I give to my Wife Rebecca
Bache for and during the Term of her natural Life the Interest of all such Sums of Money
as shall be due owing and payable to me at the time of my Decease upon Mortgaiges
Bonds Notes or otherwise Also I give to my said Wife Rebecca Bache the house of all and
singular my Household Goods and Furnitire in my now Dwelling House in Bridgnorth
aforesaid for and during the Term of her natural life with liberty for my said Wife at her
Decease to give and dispose of all the Furniture of the Best Chamber together with the
Largest Round Table and Glass in the Parlour in my said now Dwelling House with
all my Plate Linen and China to such person and persons and in such Shares and
proportions as my said Wife shall think fit to do

proportions as my said Wife shall by her last Will and Testament attested by two or more
credible Witnesses direct or appoint And I give and Bequeath All the rest and residue of
my personal Estate of what nature or kind soever Subject to the payment of my Debts
Funeral Expences and probat of this my Will to my said Nephew John Bach & his Executors
and Administrators for ever whom I constitute sole Executor of this my Will and revoke
all former Wills by me made In Witness whereof I have to this my last Will and
Testament contained in three Sheets of paper to the first and second Sheets set my Hand and
to the last Sheet thereof my Hand and Seal this Twenty Eighth Day of July in the year
our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty One.
