Dear Robert,

Here I come again. Noting all you notes in our Family Circle in the Hampton Library, perhaps you may know something additional to the following (sorry I did not copy down page nos.)

Elizabeth Ann Robert m. Thomas Benjamin Singleton, son of Benjamin Singleton + Elizabeth St. John, after Benjamin's death, Eliz. St. John m. John Jones (an uncle of mine - way back) who made will in St. Peter's Parish 1771. proved 1774. They had no children. John's parents, Thomas Jones d. 1761 in Prince George's Parish + Jane —, Jane then m. Thomas Singleton 1719-1772, who is listed in our family circle on the page before Eliz. Ann Robert + Thos. B. Singleton. I've been told that Jane's maiden name was Ford. Do you know?

Thos. Jones (d. 1761) left a personal estate appraised at £17,585 exclusive of land. Also a will. He owned 1,600 head of cattle @ £5 per head, expensive beds etc.

If you can add anything to this, shall certainly appreciate. Thos. Jones is my earliest Jones ancestor. No proof of his parentage.

Haven't gotten back to Barnwell Court House as I don't feel any too well these days.

The book on my father's ancestry is at printers. Spent 15 years on it. All Burke + Scraven Co. Ga. people - Bonnell - Freeman - Godbee - Mobley - Nesmith - Ponder - Reddick - Royal.

I'm also related by marriage (1850) to the Humbert family. Katherine Garnett's grandmother was a sister to my mother's great uncle's (Charles W. Jones) wife Eliz. Humbert.
