Dear Bob:

It is very good that you are working, and the results show up in the above noted TRANSACTION.

May I correct an ERROR, which seems extremely hard to stop: Capt Peter ROBERT (c 1738- 12/19/1807 Bayou Sara, Loftus Hill, Wilkinson County, Miss. Territory) pages 69 & 141, was b 15 January 1758, according to GA. REPUBLICAN & SAVANNAH REPUBLICAN NEWS PAPER NOTICE of his death 3/19/1808. His son James died about the same day, at the same place. As far as can be determined, he never came to Rapides Parish, La., and if he did, it was just for a short "look-visit".

Wilkinson County, Miss. Probate Book I:24 10 March 1808 names Jos. Robert, Adm. Inventory & Accounty Book I: 24-25, 136 July 1808, & Supplement to Inventory March 1809; Orphans Court No. Book or Page, dated 7 March 1808 & 15 July 1808; along with Inventory Book III: p 97 (98 & 99?) Sale of Estate confirm the News Paper Data.

For some reason, I was sure this was sent to you, when my notes of 2/78 were found, I know a copy was sent to H. S. of S.C. (Notes re-copied from 3/73).

As I wrote Mrs. Burns - Charleston - "This work is almost impossible to keep 100% free of errors".

Page 141: Elias Robert, Surveyor, died Jan. 13, 1820 at the Residence of Elias G. Jaudon, Black Swamp, S. C. age 71 years 7 months. (6/1749) Georgis Republican July 30, 1820. (His wife Mary Roux d 1815, Yamasee Bluff, Ga.) His Thomas had db 1815-20 & their descendents added, or officials added the "s".
