

Abstract of the Will of JOHN H. ROBERT

copied by EKS in the Ordinary's office of Beaufort Co., S.C. in Will Bk. I, pgs. 158-163, incl.

The Will of JOHN H. ROBERT is dated 21 Dec. 1833, and Tom Lawton of Allendale, S.C. said that it was re-filed after the Civil War. All Beaufort records were destroyed during the War.

John H. Robert, of St. Peter Parish, Beaufort District, State of South Carolina,

- (1) Bequeaths to his wife ANNA M. ROBERT, "my PLEASANT HILL PLANTATION, on which I now reside"...etc.... also "my BLOUNT HILL PLANTATION" near TURKEY HILL", on which I formerly resided....etc...
- (2) Bequeaths to his son WILLIAM H. F. ROBERT, plantation, ("TURKEY HILL"), lands, etc., and mentions that this property is "in addition to that left him by his Grandfather SAMUEL MANER."
- (3) To his son LUCIUS C. ROBERT, plantation and pinelands, and 1/2 of 2 tracts undivided "Left me by my Father JOHN ROBERT" (The Plantation is named as "COTTON HILL PLANTATION"
- (4) To his son JOHN HANCOCK ROBERT, "MOUNT HOPE PLANTATION" etc.etc.
- (5) Bequeaths to daughters, Cornelia E. Riley, Sarah Isabella A. Robert, and Elizabeth Ann Robert.
 - (6) To Grandson RICHARD FRANKLIN BOSTICK
 - (70) To son-in-law BENJAMIN R. BOSTICK
 - (8) To daughter-in-law, ELIZABETH ROBERT.

And Lastly: Appoints "My wife Anna M. Robert during her widowhood and no longer, Executrix and my Brother, William H. Robert Executor of this will
