of James and Mary Graham, who reared a family of nine children. The father died in Madison County, and in 1833 the widow, with her sons James and George W., joined the settlement in Big Lick Township, locating in Section 14. John Graham served twenty-four consecutive years as justice of the peace, and six as commissioner of Hancock County. He died in Findlay in the fall of 1885. George W. died upon the old homestead, and James in Minnesota, whither he had removed.

Baldsworth and Mary Baringer came about the same time as the Grams. They were natives of Germany, and immigrated to Maryland, thence came west to Stark County, Ohio, in 1823 or 1824, and some eight years afterward settled in the southeast quarter of Section 2, Big Lick Township, entered May 22, 1833, where both resided till their death. They had a family of ten children. Joseph, the eldest son, now occupies the old homestead, and is one of the substantial farmers of the township.

In the fall of 1833 two pioneers came here together and put up cabins in the forest of Big Lick. These men were William Roller and his son-in-law, John Moore. Both were natives of Pennsylvania, and came to Hancock from Richland (now Ashland) County, Ohio. Mr. Roller erected his cabin on Section 15, and, in the spring of 1834, brought out his family, consisting of his wife, Nancy, and eight children. Soon after coming to Big Lick he was elected justice of the peace, and the General Assembly of 1836 appointed him associate judge of Hancock County, which position he held thirteen years. He entered 1,120 acres of land in the fall of 1833, most of which was inherited by his children; he and his wife died in this township. Of their children, Michael, the eldest son, resides on Section 7, and two of the daughters, Mrs. John Moore and Mrs. Moses McAnelly, are also living in the township. Mr. Roller won and retained many friends during his residence in the county.

John Moore built his cabin in the northwest quarter of Section 15, now the farm of his son-in-law, A. J. Moore. He married Agnes W. Roller in the fall of 1833, and removed to this township the following spring. Their first-born, Nancy, the wife of A. J. Moore, was rocked in a sugar trough, which Mr. Moore says was made by the Wyandot chief Big River. For more than half a century Mr. Moore and his wife have borne the trials and burdens of life together. They reared a family of ten children, all of whom are living in Hancock County, and seven in the vicinity of the old homestead, only one now remaining at home. Mr. Moore purchased his present farm of John Huff, in 1866, who removed to Missouri. He is one of the substantial pioneer farmers of Big Lick, where he settled over fifty years ago, comparatively penniless. Few men of his times can point to a more honorable life than this successful old settler, who is highly respected by young and old throughout this portion of the county.

Jesse Wiseley, a native of Fairfield County, Ohio, built his cabin on the southeast quarter of Section 7, in 1835. Mr. Wiseley brought with him his wife, Keziah, and son, John, and thus began life in the wilderness. He claims to have erected the first frame house in the township, which is yet standing. Mr. Wiseley has lived upon the same farm since coming to the county.

Henry and Jane Thomas, natives of Ireland, immigrated to Virginia, in 1816, thence removed to Pennsylvania, and about 1827, to Wayne County, Ohio. In October, 1833, Mr. Thomas entered 320 acres of land in the

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WILLIAM ROLLER,

One of the Associate Judges of the Common Pleas Court of the county, was also a resident of this township. As a Judge, his good common sense, and honesty of action, gave him his very flattering reputation. Honest in his convictions, sympathetic in his feelings, he could hardly err in his decisions, as he was a man of average intelligence and fair common school education. He never abandoned the occupation of a farmer, but succeeded in amassing a competency, and leaving a considerable inheritance to his children. He was respected by his neighbors, and was always a friend to those in need. Unostentatious in his private life, and courteous in public, he could not but have hosts of friends.

FREEDOM.

Uriah E. Drake laid out *forty-eight* lots on the east half of the south-west quarter of section nineteen, on the 26th day of October, 1836, and called them the town of Freedom. So far as I can learn, the above is a complete history of the place.

WEST INDEPENDENCE.

George Wyant, Peter Wyant and Henry M. Grose were the proprietors of this town. It is located on the east part of the east half of the north-east quarter of section two, and at present has a population of *one hundred and thirty-four*. The Evangelical Association have a church building, and there is a good, comfortable school house in the village. The business of the place consists of *one* hotel, *one* grocery and provision store, *one* saw mill, *two* shoe shops, *one* physician and *one* blacksmith and wagon shop.

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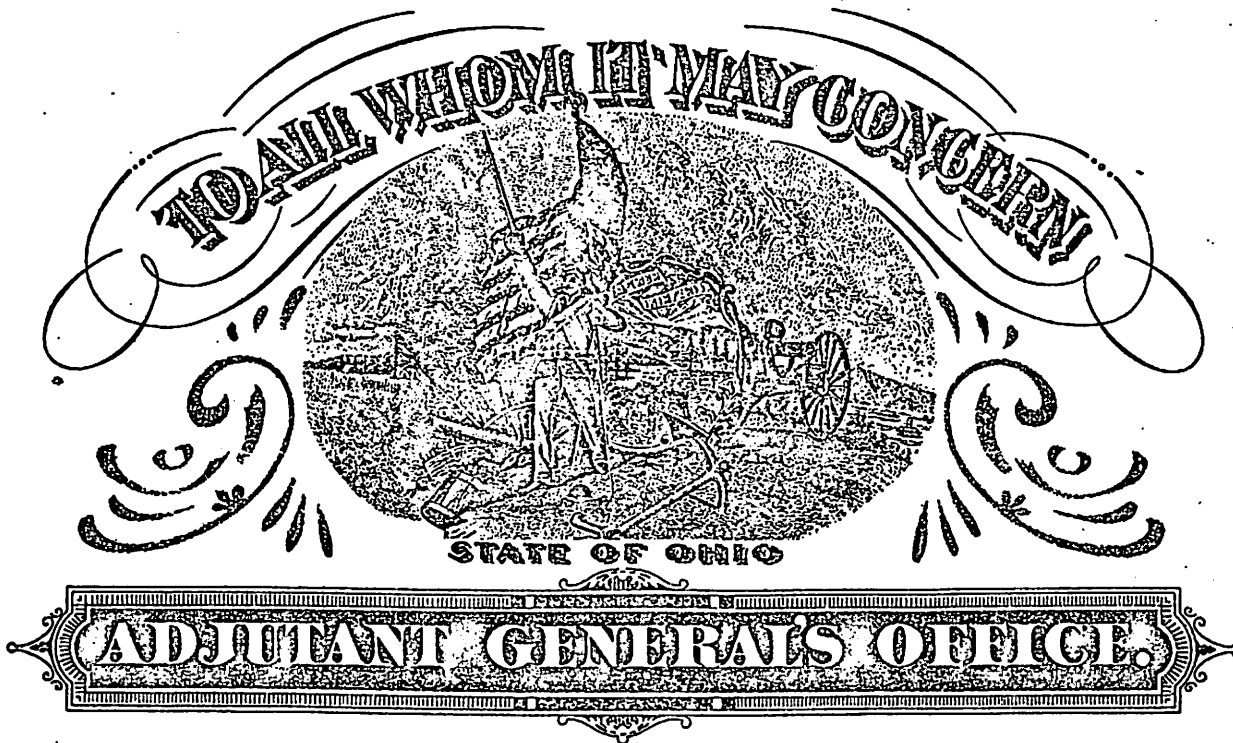

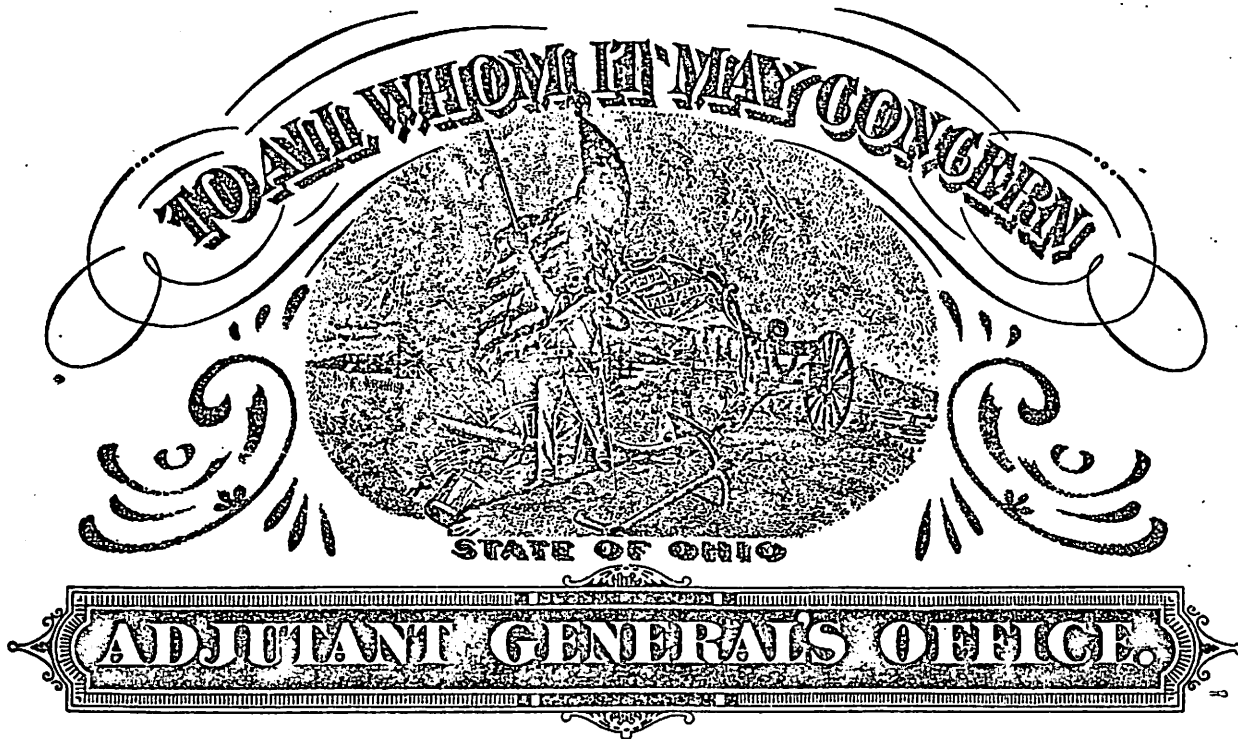

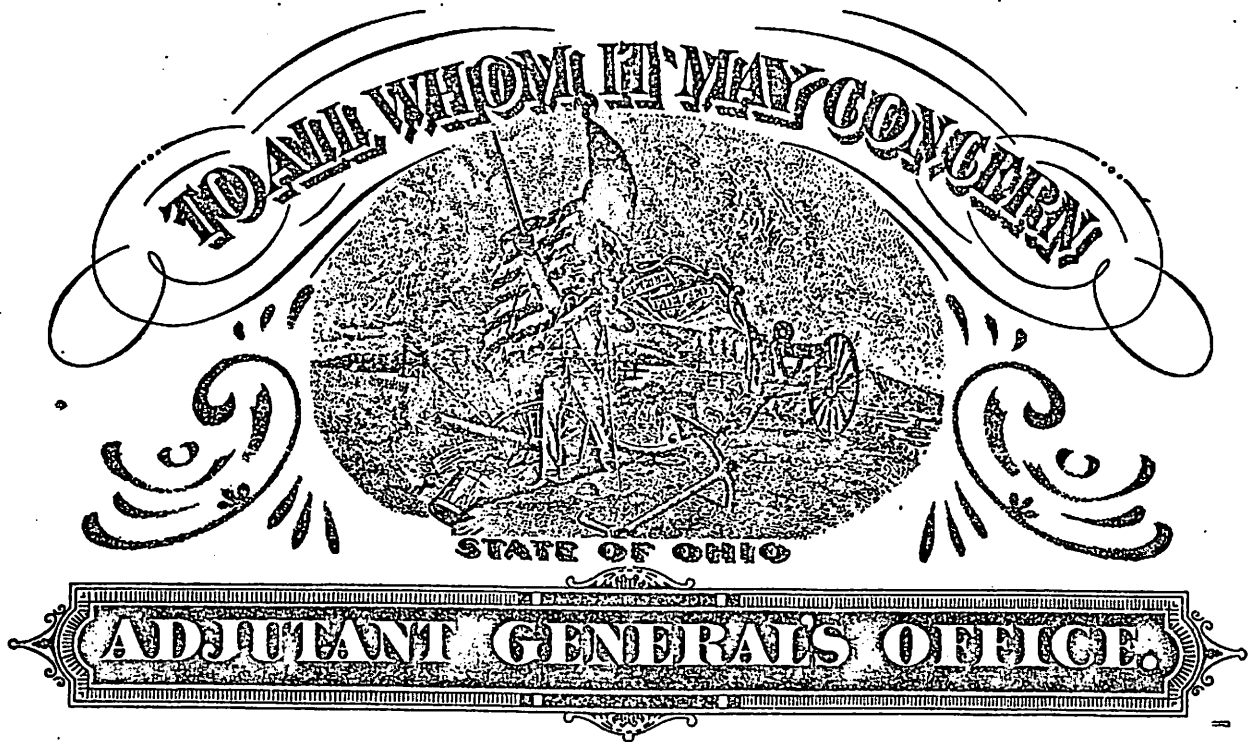

Jacob Henry Furry b 1797, Franklin County, PA d- June 21, 1866, Lake Twp Wood County, OH. He is buried in Woodville Cemetery, Sandusky County, OH on lot #307, Brown addition. Age 69 years.

Fanny (Butler) Furry his wife. She was b 1804, Franklin County, PA. and d- August 21, 1887, Lake Township, Wood County, OH. She is buried in Woodville Cemetery Sandusky County, OH on lot #307, Brown Addition. Age 73
Jacob and Fanny Furry were the parents of nine children:

1- Jacob H. Furry b march 9, 1828 in PA. d- July 1895. He is buried in Freedom Township Cemetery, Wood County, OH. This is sometimes referred to as the Long Cemetery and by others as the Pemberville Cemetery. Age 69.

2- George Furry b Stark County, OH 25 July 1831; d- 10 April 1912. He is buried in Troy Township Cemetery Wood County, OH. He resided at Stony Ridge, Troy Township, Wood County, OH. Age 81 Years.

3- William Furry b 1833 Stark County, OH d- 9 January 1902, Age 69. He is buried in Troy Township Cemetery, Wood County, OH. Grave lot is due west of his brother's (George). He resided on the old Furry homestead in Lake Township, Wood County, OH.

4- Jane E. Furry b Wood County, OH 27 March 1835; d- 27 July 1913. She is buried in Fort Meigs Cemetery, Perrysburg, Wood County, Ohio under the name Jane E. wife of Osemon Wetmore. She resided in Middleton Township, Wood County, OH and later later years were spent in Perrysburg. OH.

Jacob H. Furry, son of Jacob and Fanny (Butler) Furry was born in Stark County, OH 9 March 1828 and d- July 1895. Jacob was a member of Co. "E" 72nd Ohio Volunteer Infantry (O. V. I.) in the war 1861-1865. He enlisted at Stony Ridge, OH, in the latter part of 1861 for a three year term. His wife Elenora Catherine (Lahman) Furry was b-14 Nov. 1847 and d- 21 Apr 1910. She is buried on the same lot as her husband Jacob- to the north of large monument. They resided at 324 East Front Street, Pemberville, OH. Jacob ran a butcher shop in the same block just a few doors west of his home.

Children:

1- Minnie C., b 1869 and d-1951 at 83 years of age. She never married and remained at home with her parents.

2- Jessie Furry B. _____ married Henry Driftmyer and resided at Pemberville, OH., later moving to Gibsonburg, OH, where she spent her remaining years. They had two children: Roscoe who never married and Garnet who was an invalid.

3- William H. Furry- son of Jacob and Catherine was b- 1874 and d- 1908. He fell from an oil well derrick and was killed. He is buried beside his father on the same lot. William Furry ^{married} Cora E. Hampshire. She was from Haton, OH in Wood County. She was born 1880 and died 1966. Their children were: a son Glen who resides in Cleveland and a daughter Thelma M. Furry b- 1902 d- 1968. She was a registered Nurse and worked in Public Health service in Cleveland, OH.

4- Anson L. Furry b 1878 and d- 1943. He married his brother William's widow. He was a conductor on the old Toledo, Fostoria and Findley inter-urban railroad and had no children. He is buried on the lot adjoining his father's. William H. Furry was working in the oil fields at Robinson, IL., and fell from the top of an oil derrick and was killed. The derrick was between 55 feet and 60 feet high. William's accident was a very tragic one. In the fall he fell a stradle of some of the cross braces on the derrick. He lived several hours. They had no ambulance service and hospitals were few and far between. His wife and mother received a wire but by the time they arrived he was dead. In those days they did not have

the means of pain relief available today. This information was submitted to me by word of mouth by Mr. Evan Perry who is 81 years old and moved to Pemberville in 1900, being neighbors to the Furry family for many years. Glen Furry came to visit him this past Memorial Day (30 May 1971). This information was gathered 24 June 1971.

2- George Furry, son of Jacob and Fanny (Butler) Furry was born in Stark County OH, 25 July 1831 and died 10 April 1912. He was a member of the 189th O. V. I. in the war 1861-1865 in Co. "G". His first wife was Sarah J. Muncheater. They were married 25 May 1862 in Scott Township, Sandusky County, OH. She died in Lake Township 1867 leaving George with two little girls. She is buried on Jacob's and Fanny's Furrys lot #307, Brown addition, Woodville Cemetery, Woodville, OH. His second wife Elizabeth (Wicks) Furry was born 5 March 1847 and died 13 April 1930 and is buried beside him to the south of the large monument.

3- William Furry, son of Jacob and Fanny (Butler) Furry was born in Stark County, OH, 3 May 1833 and died 9 January 1902, age 69 years. He was a member of Company "E", 72nd O.V.I. in the war of 1861-1865. His first wife was Hannah Akenberger by whom he had one son Edgar born 1866 and died 1929. He then married Hattie Wicks who was born 23 October 1851 and died 17 January 1931 at 79 years of age and is buried beside him to the right of the large monument. Palmer E. Furry, b- 23 August 1880, d- 17 May 1946 is buried on the same lot with his parents. Reading from left to right are three other graves, Mother- Mary A. Furry 1870-1944, Harry L. d- 19 August 1884 age 1 year., Father- John J. Furry 1872-1928.

There is a Jonas William Furry 1870-1957 and his wife Adelia M. Furry 1872-1948, both names on the same stone and buried in Troy Township Cemetery, Wood County, OH. He was the son of William and Hattie (Wicks) Furry. There is a Floyd A. Furry, 1878-1945 and his wife Ada b- 1879 and d- 1973. Both names are on a monument in Lake Township Cemetery, Wood County, OH. He was a son of William and Hattie also.

The children of William and Hattie are:

Jonas W. Furry b- 1870-1957; John J. Furry, 1872-1928; Henry B. Furry, 1875-1929; Floyd A. Furry, 1878-1945; Palmer E. Furry, 1880-1946; Harry L. Furry, 1883-1884; Irvin E. Furry, 1885-1955; Ray R. Furry, 1890- . William also had a son Edgar by his first marriage to Hannah Akenburger b- 1866-1929.

4- Jane Elizabeth Furry, Daughter of Jacob and Fanny (Butler) Furry was b- 27 March 1835, Lake Township, Wood County. She married Sherman Andrew Jackson, son of Aaron Gregory and Miranda (Bushnell) Jackson. Jane E. d- 27 July 1913 and is buried in Fort Meigs cemetery beside her second husband Osemond M. Wetmore whom she married 5 December 1870. Her marriage to Sherman A. Jackson was 30 December 1852, Stony Ridge, Wood County, OH. He was b- 3 February 1829 in ~~Scioto~~ County, OH. , and d- 10 January 1865 in the Confederate Prison, Andersonville, GA., and is buried in the Andersonville National cemetery, GA. His designated grave sight is #12428. He enlisted in Company "E" 72nd O. V. I. at Stony Ridge, OH in the later part of 1861 for a three year period. He was 29 years old at the time of his enrollment in the Civil War. The highest rank he obtained was Sargeant. He was captured June 11, 1864 near Ripley, Mississippi. Sargeant Jackson, along with the rest of his Regiment, Arrived back in Fremont, Oh., on 28 February 1864 on furlough, but on 5 April 1864 moved on to Cleveland, OH, recruited to a strength of 500 men and then went to Mississippi. That was the one and only time he saw his family after enlistment. There still exists two letters that he wrote home to his wife, Jane Elizabeth. There is also a picture of him in uniform.

Children born to Jane Elizabeth (Furry) and Sherman Andrew Jackson are:

1- Almeria Miranda (Knull) b- 25 May 1853 and d- 1940 and is buried beside her husband Ira L. Knull b- 1845 and d- 1919 with burial in Fort Meigs cemetery Ferrysburg, OH. Both names appear on the same monument. Ira was a member of Company "L" 3rd O. V. G. in the war of 1961-1965.

2- Harriet Emma (Emery) b- 6 October 1855 and d- . She is buried in Collingwood cemetery, Toledo, OH. *Phillips ave. No marker.*

3- Gregory Sherman Jackson b-28 January 1859 and d- 1928. He is buried in the New Belleville Ridge cemetery, Wood County, OH on the same lot as his sister Falinda. It is known that he had a wife named Mary.

4 and 5 were twins-

4- Malinda Alinda (Hampton) b- 11 June 1861 Lake Township Wood County, OH and d- 19 December 1939 and is buried beside her husband Warren Watson Hampton son of Joseph and Eliza Jane (Wilson) Hampton. He was one of their seven children. He was born in Plain Township, Wood County, OH May 29, 1850 and d- 12 June 1901 and is buried beside his wife Malinda (Jackson) in Union Hill Cemetery, Plain Township, Wood County, OH. He married Malinda Alinda Jackson 26 July 1879.

Malinda A. Hampton later married Issac E. Ward _____ . Issac was born 14 October 1853 and died 18 November 1941. He was born in Center Township, Wood County, OH son of Issac Ward b-Ohio and Rosena (Lantz) b- PA. Father, Mother and son are buried in Webster Township cemetery, Scotch Ridge, Wood county, OH. Divorce Records of Wood County, OH shows Lantie Ward plaintiff v.s. Issac E. Ward defendant. Divorce granted 3 September 1890. Filed 17 October 1890. Issac had three sons by his first marriage, William, Harley and Dorsie. No children by second marriage (Malinda A. Hampton).

5- Phalinda (Falinda) Elizabeth (Hale) b- 11 June 1861 Lake Township, Wood County, OH, d- 1929 and is buried in New Belleville Ridge Cemetery, Wood CO, OH. beside her husband Lafayette Hale. They were married 8 September 1904, ^{14 March 1902} Wood County, OH. Lafayette Hale served was a member of Co. "H", 21st O. V. I. in the war of 1861-1865. Two children were born from this union: Rawleigh and Arthur Hale. Lafayette Hale was killed in a train accident. On the 15 February 1905 Phalinda E. Hale entered into a second marriage to John D. Tyler, age 50 and born in Huron, OH. He was a merchant. He was the son of Martin D. and Hannah (Petty) Tylor. The license for marriage of Phalinda and John Tylor was issued 8 September 1904.

Jane Elizabeth (Furry) Jackson married Osemond M. Wetmore of Middletown Township, Wood County, OH, on 5 December 1870. To this union was born one daughter Flora M. Wetmore 3 November 1871 and d- 17 January 1872. Osemond Wetmore was b- 18 March 1817 and d- 27 September 1890. They resided in Middleton Township, Wood County, OH and are buried in Fort Meigs Cemetery, Perrysburg, OH.

On the 21 August 1898 Jane Elizabeth Wetmore married Joseph Dunham Simmons. From the U. S. Census of 1870 gives the following information; Simmons, Joseph, age 45, farmer- realproperty \$3500 and personal property of \$400, b- England, Phebe, age 39 b- State of Ohio, keeps house; children- John 17, Miron 16, Dunham 14, Frank 8, William 5- all children born in Ohio. (Information taken from Wood County, Perrysburg Township and submitted by Mike Sebberson, 1974. Mr. Simmons was a veteran of the war of 1861-1865 and served in 100th O. V. I. He died 1 May 1912 and is buried in Fort Meigs Cemetery.

6- John H. Furry son of Jacob and Fanny (Butler) Furry was B-1839 Troy Township, Stony Ridge, Wood County, OH and d- 1888. He was a member of Company "E" 72 O. V. I. in the war of 1861-1865. He enlisted at the same

time as Jacob and William and was in the same company. His wife, Alinda A. (Hineline) Furry, b- 1837 d- 4 November 1919 at 82 years of age. She was born at Easton, PA. She is buried on the same lot- to the right of John. Two other graves on the same lot, one to the right of Alinda A. (Hugh W. Furry 1880-1952) and one to the left. This grave also has a Spanish American War Veterans emblem beside the stone. John and Alinda were married at Fremont, Sandusky County, Ohio. 19 November 1864. Alinda's Mother's name was Rebecca Letting and father's name was Hugh B. Hineline. They came from Pennsylvania to Rice in Sandusky County in 1854. Alinda was one of fourteen children. Two of her brothers lost their lives in the war of 1861-1865.

Jacob Furry (1797-1866) and Fanny (Butler) Furry (1804-1887) were residents of Troy township and later of Lake township both in Wood county, OH. Their place of burial is in the Woodville cemetery, Sandusky Co., Oh on lot #307 in what is known as Brown addition. It is an eight grave lot, 32 ft. x 8 ft. The large pinnacle style monument is inscribed on the west side Jacob Furry, June 26, 1866 age 68 yrs. 8 mo. and 24 days. To the right is head marker Jacob. To the right of Jacob's marker is one - William H.- marker; marker to the east of the monument has the initials J. F. which I take to be his wife Fanny; next head marker to the east reads Hannah, wife of William Furry d- May 6, 1868 age 24 yrs, 9 mo. 28 days; next marker east is a design of a small lamb with the name Cora inscribed on it.

John H. Furry, son of Jacob and Fanny Furry along with his wife, Alinda A. Furry; John H. 1839-1888; Alinda A. 1837-1919; marker to the right of Alinda's reads Hugh W. Furry 1880-1952; one to the left of large monument reads John A. Furry 1871-1916. This one has the Spanish- American War Emblem. These graves are five on lot #254 first addition and one grave on lot 227 second division. John evidently owned two lots adjoining each other in the Woodville cemetery.

In Woodville cemetery, Sandusky County, Ohio there is an Edgar G. Furry 1866-1941 and his wife Emma S. Furry 1867-1942 buried on the Sherburn A. Harris lot #200 3rd addition. Edgar G. Was a son of William by his first wife Hannah Akenburger. There is a Caroline Furry b- 21 August 1871 and d- 10 June 1950 buried on William Miller's lot #292, 3rd addition due east of Edgar on Harris lot, same row. Also on this lot is a William Miller (OVI Veteran); also, Julia Miller and Cora M.

According to the cemetery clerk's plot sheet and records there is a Charley Furrey buried on H. H. Harris lot # 27, 3rd addition, two graves. (We did not locate it. He said to look for the large Hartman monument close by.)

According to the history of Troy and Lake Townships situated in the north eastern part of Wood County in the State of Ohio, Jacob and Fanny Furry settled in the norther part of Troy township in the year of 1833 and an old map dated 1875 shows 80 acres in section #32 Lake twpas as the estate of Jacob Furry. When he purchased the land it was covered with large trees and was very wet. It was within the two mile limits of the western reserve road land ceded to the United States Government from the Indians for the purpose of a road leading from Lower Sandusky to the foot of of the rapids of the Maumee River. Jacob Furry held road ^{contract} #41 on the western reserve road that the government started to cut through in 1825 westward from Lower Sandusky.

First office holder (a justice of peace) in Troy twp was selected by a body of fifteen men. These electors were appointed by a Judge of Courts within the County. Jacob was one of the fifteen appointed. The man appointed as Justice of the Peace took office 5 June 1835. In 1841 Jacob was listed as one of three men serving as trustee for Troy township. He was listed among the male inhabitants (breadwinner) from Troy Township, Wood County, OH in 1839. On June 15, 1844 Lake Township was formed from Troy Township (a portion of it), some of Perrysburg to the west and land to the east to the Sandusky County line. From that date on Jacob and Fanny Furry were listed as residents of Lake Township. Jacob served as a trustee 1845-1846 in Lake Township. He was one of two men who served as assessor in 1860. Jacob and Fanny were charter members of Stony Ridge Methodist Episcopal Church when it was formed in 1840.

From History of Wood County, OH. (We have in our possession a picture of the log house that Jacob and Fanny built in the early years. At time the picture was taken Jacob was gone but Grandmother Fanny was living at the place with their son, William and family. (Note by Hampton Roller)

Warren Watson Hampton son of Joseph and Eliza Jane (Wilson) Hampton, one of seven children, was born in Plain Twp., Wood County, Ohio on May 29, 1850. He died 12 June 1901 and is buried beside his wife Malinda A. (Jackson) Hampton in Union Hill Cemetery, Plain Twp., Wood County, Ohio. In Middleton Twp., Wood County, OH on 26 July 1879 Warren W. Hampton married Malinda Alinda

Jackson who was born in Lake Township Wood County, Ohio a daughter of Sherman A. Jackson and his wife Jane E. Furry. To this union were born six children;

1-. Maude Adele (Roller) b- 14 July 1880, d- 21 February 1970, bur- New Belleville Ridge Cemetery on lot # 137A, Dowling, OH, Wood county beside her husband Jay C Roller.

2-. Bernice Grace (Cox) b- 8 August 1882, d- 30 October 1933, bur., beside her husband Lewis B. Cox in Toledo Memorial Cemetery, Sylvania, OH.

3-. James William b- 17 March 1884, d- 26 September 1943, buried beside his mother and father in Union Hill Cemetery. He ^{married} Zerinah Frances Belles from Columbus, OH. To this union were born two daughters: Helen, who died quite young and Florence. James William Hampton was a member of 166th Infantry, 42 Division, World War I. Florence grew to womanhood and married Hunter S. Shober and to this union one child was born, Florence b- 7 May 1932, d- 22 June 1933, buried in Union Hill Cemetery beside her grandmother Zernah Frances Hampton. Frances died 13 January 1947, b- 2 October 1885. in the U. S. (Information from death certificate recorded Wood County, OH.) On the same lot # 117, section 2 along with Hunter L. Shrober who d- 10 August 1939 is a Government marker that reads "Colorado Sgt., 115 Field Sig. Bat., 40 Division". James W. requested that he be buried beside his mother so he was.

4-. Pearl Eliza (McMann), b- 20 January 1888, d- Toledo, OH. and is buried in Woodlawn Cemetery beside her husband Grover C. McMann

5-. Cora Viola, b- 23 July 1890, d- 11 September 1891, buried in Union Hill Cemetery on the same lot beside her father and mother.

6-. Helen Fern b- 22 March 1899, d- 11 September 1928, buried on same lot beside her father and mother in Union Hill Cemetery, She never married.

Joseph Hampton and Eliza Jane (Hampton), the father and mother of Warren W. Hampton are both buried in Union Hill Cemetery in the older part on the hill both names are on the same monument. Joseph, b- 25 November 1825 in Ross County, OH. d- 26 March 1895 in Plain Township, Wood County, Ohio. Eliza Jane Wilson was b- 18 December 1829 in Mercer County Pennsylvania and d- 18 March 1903 Plain Township, Wood County, Ohio. A son of theirs, Manley b- 14 April 1864 d- 10 July 1875 is buried on same lot beside his father and mother. A small pinnacle for a headstone marks the grave. The marker is very weatherbeaten and it is hard to read the name and dates. Joseph and Eliza were married 16 November 1847 then removed to Plain Township, Wood County, OH in the fall of 1848

on to a tract of land. Joseph was a carpenter, stone and brick mason by trade.

Malinda A. Hampton, Warren W. Hampton's widow later married Issac E. Ward who was b- 14 October 1853 and d- 18 November 1941 and is buried in Webster Township Cemetery, Wood County, OH. The divorce records filed 17 October 1890 that Issac A. and Lantle Wards were divorced 3 September 1890.

Maude Adele Hampton, daughter of Warren Watson and Malinda A. (Jackson) Hampton was united in marriage to Jay C Roller, b- 31 October 1876 in Middleton Township, Wood County, OH and d- 3 January 1960. He was one of a family of four sons and three daughters of William and Martha (Ruckman) Roller of Middleton Township, Wood County, OH. Jay C and Maude A. were united in marriage on 18 July 1901 at Waterville, Lucas County, Ohio. To this union twelve children were born:

In terminating the past history of the Furry Family that I have looked up, I realize that it is far from complete but by reading the History of Wood County, published in 1897, visiting various cemeteries, talking with others and remembering what our mother said, I have set it down so others can read this and if they care to search further or pick it up wherever they choose to do so. Now as to Sherman Jackson and where he was born. The 1860 U. S. Census gave

place of birth State of Ohio. I cannot say that even our mother could answer that question. I have included a photostatic copy of dates of births, marriages, and deaths taken from the large Jackson Family Bible now in my possession. It was published in the year of 1910, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Mama told me she always understood that he came from Connecticut. One of the Shooks said she understood that he came here from southern Ohio. His name was shown in the bible as Andrew Sherman Jackson but his Army record shows Sherman A. Jackson. Back in those days it was very easy to switch your first and middle name around. It looks like our brother Howard and sister Ellen switched theirs according to the way our mother set it down in the Bible.

They resided 1 mile west of Stony Ridge, on Rte. #20. He was a carpenter and farmer by trade. Ray R. Furry states in his letter that as far as he knows Mrs. Stella LeFever and himself are the only living descendents in the 3rd generation of Jacob and Fanny Furry as of 1973. He also tells of the relatives buried in Woodville Cemetary.

Ray R. said there was a Maude Hampton who used to visit often in their home when he was a child. Jacob and William were both wounded at the battle of Shiloh, William was taken prisoner at Ripley, Miss. confined for 3 months at Andersonville and then sent to Florence and later to Lawton prisons all told 9 months - he was honorable discharged from the army in 1865 at Salisbury, N. C.

Note:

In reference to Jacob J. Furry, son of Jacob and Fanny Furry, as shown on page 4, who resided in Pemberville, Ohio; there was a child born on March 3, 1856 at Wabask, Indiana who was Alice Furry, who was his daughter by a first marriage.

Alice married Decator VanHellen of Perrysburg, Ohio. They were very good friends with our Grandmother, Jane Simmons. Evidently Uncle Jacob had moved to Indiana and lived there for a time before returning to Stoney Ridge by 1861.

Sherman A. Jackson appointed Second Lieutenant in the 72nd regiment Ohio Volunteer Infantry, the 9th day of April, 1864. By order of Governor, State of Ohio.

Taken prisoner at Brice's Cross Roads (Guntown), Miss., June 10, 1864; Died Jan. 10, 1865 of Plurites (Starvation). No. of grave 12428. Regiment No. 16306. Confined in Confederate Prison at Andersonville, Ga. (buried at same site)

On June 2, 1865 Jane E. Jackson, age 30, of Lake Twp., Wood County, Ohio, appeared before Edwin Tuller, Judge of Probate Court of Record to obtain the benefits of the provision made by the act of Congress approved July 14, 1862, that she is the widow of Sherman A. Jackson, who was a Lieutenant in Company "E" 72nd Regiment of Ohio Volunteer Infantry, that during the existance of the marriage there was born five children who are now under the age of sixteen years. Almeria M. Jackson born May 12, 1854, Harriet E. Jackson, born Oct. 6, 1856, Gregory S. Jackson, born Jan. 30, 1859, Falinda and Malinda Jackson, (twins), born June 12, 1861.

Later on Jane E. Jackson was granted a certificate, No. 75247, giving her a pension of \$8.00 per month commencing January 10, 1865, also the additional sum of \$2.00 per month for each of said children commencing July 25, 1866; Osmond M. Wetmore was the children's legal guardian. This paper drawn year 1871.

Osmond M. Wetmore and Jane Elizabeth Jackson were married December 5, 1870. Residence and Post Office address is Perrysburg, Wood County, Ohio. Wetmore died Sept. 27, 1890.

Dunham Simmons and Jane E. Wetmore were married August 4, 1898. Dunham Simmons Died May 1, 1912. Jane E. Wetmore died July 27, 1913.

After Mr. Simmons died Jane E. applied for restoration of her account #75247 pension for herself gave her age 76 years.

From the Manuscript First Chapter of THE MUIR FAMILY 1777-1977

as written by Mrs. Charlotte Dunipace Shaw

The writer remembers clearly from her childhood the charm of the old Fenton house in Scotch Ridge, with its abundance of gingerbread trimming the eaves, the tiny lattice-sided front stoop opening into the living room and its beautifully designed front door, solid wood with gracefully shaped inset panel. The house, the fourth east from the four corners of Scotch Ridge and still standing though totally changed by remodelling, was built on the slope of a little hill, so that the basement had a ground level entrance. What fun it was on a hot summer day to walk barefooted on the smooth cool dampness of that "mud" floored cellar. But the unforgettable feature of the house was the exquisitely done ceiling which the owner kept covered with wallpaper. The writer happened to be there one day when the ceiling paper had been removed prior to re-papering and remembers vividly the huge circular floral design painted a yellow-ivory but the all over floral design of the center was very dark, with lots of red flowers, which seemed to stand out, roses, poppies, - the writer has forgotten. A wide stripe of a color darker than the ceiling but still lighter than the overall tones of the floral design similar to the center was painted out to each corner, where a smaller floral design similar to the center was painted. Only in Blair Castle near Blair Atholl in Perthshire, Scotland has the writer ever seen anything like it. There each corner of the dining room ceiling has an oil painting of one of the four seasons. If memory serves, there is a similar type of ceiling decoration at Scone Palace, near Perth. Certainly the writer has never seen anything like the Fenton house living room ceiling around our area here.
