Will of HUGH ROSE of Stamford, co. of Delaware, to wife Elizabeth all household furniture in addition to her thirds or dower rights; to daughters Abigail and Catharine use of west rooms as long as either remain single, also bed and bedding; also to Abigail \$200 to be paid by son Hugh Rose Jr.; also to Catherine \$200 to be paid by son Hugh Rose Jr.; to son Edmund Rose yoke oxen and \$400, \$100 when he arrives at 21 and \$100 a year after; give nothing to daughters who are married having provided heretofore to my ability; to son Hugh Rose Jr. all residue also wife's dower in real estate after her decease. Appoints wife Elizabeth and said Hugh Rose Jr. executors. Signed: Hugh Rose. Wit.: Levinus Monson of Hobart; Robert Menzie of Hobart. Proved: 15 Dec. 1841. Dated: 8 July 1836.

Will of ELON ROSE of town of Sidney, Delaware Co., to wife Murilla H. Rose all property real and personal, after her decease executor to divide in six equal parts; 1 to daughter Sarah Bloodgood, one to son John W. Rose; one to daughter Orpha Chase; one to surviving children of decd daughter Esther L. Parsons share alike; one to surviving child of decd son Nathan Rose share alike; one to surviving children of son Lewis Rose share alike. Appoints J. V. E. Kinne of Sidney Plains, N.Y. executor. Signed: Elon (his x mark) Rose. Dated: 4 Jan.

**Estate Box 49, Estate of ELLEN ROSE**

Estate of Ellen Rose, petition to prove heirs, Ellen Rose, late of Delhi, New York, died at Delhi, 5 Feb. 1870, left surviving her John Kingston, brother and this deponent, Mary Schelly, her sister who were the only heirs at law and next of kin known to be living; that then a niece of Ellen who about 20 years ago lived in City of New York by name of Ann Morris, but deponent has not seen or heard of her. James Rosa of Town of Walton, Delaware Co., age 77, makes will, to wife Catharine, right to use of real estate and personal property during life and as long as she remains widow, if she marries, to cease. At death of wife to my four children, Catharine Simmons, Mary Rosa, William H. Rosa, Nelson Rosa. Executor, James Rogers Esq. Will dated 21 May 1875. Signed by x mark. Wit.: G. W. Robinson, resident of Walton, N.Y.; Miles Brawley, res. of same. Proved: 20 Sept. 1875.

**Estate Box R, Estate of JAMES ROSA**

Estate of James Rosa, late of Town of Walton, farmer, departed this life 27 May 1875. Petition of James D. Rogers of Town of Walton: states he died leaving will, left heirs and next of kin: James Rosa and William H. Rosa of Masonville, co. of Delaware; Nelson Rosa and Catherine Simmons, wife of Andrew Simmons, both residing in Walton; Mary E. Rosa, resident of Kingston, Ulster Co., all of full age. Catharine Rosa, resident of Walton, is widow. Dated: 5 Aug. 1878. (This is the original probate packet; the original will is not in the probate packet.)

Banger Blakely, as administratrix and administrator, all right in and to estate of father. Both sign. Ack.: 13 Dec. 1875. A similar one is given by James H. Rose, son of Hugh Rose decd. Ack.: 13 Dec. 1875. (These two documents state that the signers are over 21.) The INVENTORY shows of Town of Stamford, inventory made by Isabel Rose, administratrix and Goldsbroro B Blakely, administrator. 23 Mar. 1878. Appraisers set apart for use of widow and minor children various items for use. (This is the original probate packet.)
