(p.48, 1) HARMON (HERMAN) HENDRICK ROSENKRANS, b. 11-29-1634 (or 1630) Bergen \*, Norway - settled in Ulster Co., NY in 1657(or 1649) d. 1697 Rochester, NY., m. 3-3-1657 New Amsterdam, now New York, Magdalene Diricksen Volckersten b. 5-18-1631 Albany, NY (page 763-1863-Valentine's Manual), d. 1697Rochester, NY, she was the daughter of Dirck Volckersten and Christina Vigne. Had 9 children, *Alexander*, Annatje b.1661 d.1672, Rachel bapt. 1663 d.1697, Harmanus bapt. 1666 d.1697, Anna bapt. 1667 d.1740, Hendrick bapt. 1674 d.1721, Christiana bapt.1674 d.1726, Dirk b. betw. 1671-1673 d.1708, and Sarah b.1675 d.1726.

Note: 1649 Dirk VOLKERTSON, the Norman; early settler and farmer, Brooklyn at Bushwick Creek; built his house in 1649; he and his wife, Christina VIGNE, became members of the Dutch Reformed Church in New Amsterdam in 1649. Their daughter, Magdalena Dirks, married (1) Cornelius Hendrickson VanDORT, and married (2nd) 1657 Herman Hendrick ROSENCRANS. Source: Virkus THE COMPENDIUM OF AMERICAN GENEALOGY.

Additional Note, "Harmanus Hendrickszen ROSENKRANTZ came from Bergen, Norway to New Amsterdam about 1649. He was a soldier, and was sometimes called "Harman the Portuguese" probably in recognition of his service in Brazil, from which reinforcements had been brought in 1655. Had 7 children, Maria bapt. 1714, Harmen bapt. 1716, Magdalena bapt. 1718 d.1801, Catrina b.1719 d.1768, Johannis bapt. 1721 d.1722, *Johannis 2<sup>nd</sup>*, and Helena.

#### 4<sup>th</sup> Generation...

JOHANNIS (John) ROSEKRANS (2<sup>nd</sup>), 2<sup>nd</sup> son of Alexander, b. 5-18-1724, (or 7-6)-1724 bapt. 10-18-1724 Rochester, NY, d. 6-5,(or 15)-1786 and buried behind his home at Shappanack, NJ. Settled in Walpack, NJ, (then Morris County) in 1731. Purchased Shappanack in 1745, m. 8-8-1751 Margaret DeWitt, b. 4-18-1731 Rochester, NY. He fought in the 3<sup>rd</sup> battalion, NJ Militia in the Revolutionary War (1775-1781). Had 14 children, John b.1752 d.bef.1833, Jacob b.1754, Orianna b.1755 d. young, Orianna(2)b.1757, Alexander b.1759 d. abt.1795, Catharine b.1761, Charick DeWitt b.1764, Elijah b.1766 d.1832, Levi b.1768 d.1844, Joseph b.1770 d. 1837 (Joseph-twins-*Benjamin*), Simeon b.1772 d. young, Simeon(2) b.1775 d.1841, and Polly b.1777.

Col. John Rosenkrans service record, "Captain, 3<sup>rd</sup> Regiment, Sussex Co. Militia; elected Colonel, 3<sup>rd</sup> Regiment, Sussex Co. Militia, May 23, 1777, vice Col. John Cleves Symes resigned; commanded his regiment in Pennsylvania, under Brigadier Gen. David Forman, Sept. 17 to Oct. 12, 1777; was at the Battle of Germantown, Pa., Oct. 4, 1777; on rolls Dec. 1777, and Jan., May and June 1778; commanded his regiment at Minnisink, NJ, June 30 to July 21, 1778; commanded his regiment, companies of which were in service in Sussex Co., at Minnisink, and along the Delaware River, July thru Dec. 1778; on rolls April 1780, and May 1781. Had 11 children, William P. b.1851 d.1859, John B., Mary Alice b.1854, Daniel H. b.1855 d.1859, Jacob Linden b.1857, Anna Estella b.1860 d.1897, Emma b.1862, Catharine A. b.1864, Albert S. b.1867 and Frank b. 1871.

(not in book) JOHN RUSSELL ROSENKRANS, 1st son of John B., b. 2-28-1896 Sandyston, NJ, d. 12-7-1971 and buried in Hainesville Cemetery, NJ (Have photo of his gravestone), m. 2-13-1918 Mabel Zoe Crone of Hainesville, b. 3-30-1898. Had 3 children, Harvey Russell 6,1918, George, and Valerie Marie 6,1933. John Russell R. served in World War I. (John Russell and Mabel Zoe Crone are my Grandparents). \*\*Mabel Zoe Crone R. was 100 years old on 3-30-1981.
