Jim Gates of Fort Lauderdale, not a Shockley descendant but a researcher who has been working on these lines along with Beverly Neises and others, has shared a great deal of the information this team is getting ready to publish. I hope soon to report that this book of Shockley descents and related lines is ready to order; when it is, I'll put information on this page. Beverly and Jim are anxious to see some of the too-oft-reiterated assumptions and errors cleaned up in the records of all Shockley descendants! So feel free to change your own records on the basis of what you accept from here, and let your other contacts know about it, but please! be sure to note that Beverly Neises and Jim Gates are the researchers whose efforts yielded this data. The least we can do for all their trouble is to credit them properly when

their material is used! All changes made on the basis of their input have been flagged with this yellow star. And I do recommend buying their book when it comes out; it will be very thorough. Contact Jim if you have lines you'd like to be sure are included.

Back to the task at hand! Some major changes to note:

- David Shockley, of the first American generation, had 2 illegitimate daughters, acknowledged in his will, but improperly identified by me, previously, on the basis of a will abstract.
- Richard Shockley who was here identified as the husband of an Elizabeth Meredith now has the correct spouses entered (the first being Sarah Todvine) and he is now properly identified as the Richard who remained in MD.
- "Our" Richard Shockley the one so many of us trace to (among others, all of us who descend from Isaiah Shockley and Ruth Young) - now has <u>his descent</u> separated from that of Richard Shockley the immigrant and Ann Boyden, given that no one has been able to prove WHICH of Richard's sons & grandsons he descends from. Arguments welcome - and evidence will be "broadcast" to rejoicing!
- Further, that Richard's wife, long identified as Elizabeth Meredith, dau of James (on the basis of Burgess's conclusion, on Meredith proximity and the naming of one son "Meredith Shockley"), has now been identified as Elizabeth Adkins. Work continues on the Adkins family and related lines, particularly Owens, both of which came to America very early on
- Records of early Thomas Shockleys are needed! Please get in touch with any authoritative references you come across so that we can all try to figure out the correct descents!

For me. Shocklevs tie into Branson lines - which I'm trying to fill out; Bransons and Shocklevs both married into David and Cox families, were near Dillards. Easts, Goads ... it's an oft-connected clan that came together in Southside (Halifax and Pittsylvania counties) and Blue Ridge (Henry, Patrick, Carroll, Grayson, Wythe and Montgomery counties) Virginia in the second half of the 1700's, and came through Tennessee to Gasconade Co MO in the first decades of the 1800's.

My Shockley information began with Roy Burgess's book. "Early Missourians and Kin," a helpful beginning, but like most, the book has its share of errors; unlike most, no sources are cited, which is very unfortunate. After that, I found other published Shockley genealogies: Nancy Miller's "Shockley" and Mrs. David Tripp's "Early Shockley Families of Virginia, Tennessee, Maryland and Delaware," Before finding Jim Gates, who, with extraordinary generosity, shared what he and his partners had found, most of my data was drawn from those published sources. It has been supplemented by records from other researchers, credited in the linked footnotes.

I did some research on this line at the <u>State Archives of Maryland</u>, where I found the old marriage records, wills and land deeds. I could not connect all the Shockley deeds with the appropriate individuals with any certainty. Transcripts of Maryland records have also been used, especially Torrence's "Old Somerset on the Eastern Shore of Maryland." I have also looked into <u>Pittsylvania Co VA land records</u> and Missouri census records. There's a lot more to go through: in Delaware, Maryland, Virginia ...! I'll add to all this as I can. Since the file is so lengthy, changes will always be flagged, and any major update will be discussed in this intro. I reserve to myself 'credit' for remaining errors.

### Richard Shockley Jr

"Early Shockley Families of VA, TN, MD, DE" by Mrs David Tripp Richard was living with wife Elizabeth in Sussex Co DE in 1722. That same year he sold 200 acres of land left him by his father in Somerset Co MD. (I do not have a copy of this book)
