Many thanks for correcting my chart and returning it so promptly.

I am sending you xerox copies of several of Mattie Allston Read [ca 1910] Smith Family Notes. (S.C. H Soc has 8 note books of 150 pages each in the M A R Smith file) Please return.

I am also sending you a copy of a will I got from a genealogist in England.

Where besides the <sup>(1875)</sup> Holmes chart do you find the proof that T S (Gov) was a cousin of George Monk? The Holmes Chart has too many errors to be acceptable proof.

I am confused about John Atkins, [will d 1681 prov 1681 of Chard] he speaks of his daughter Joan Smith, and evidently cuts her off, wife of Thomas Smith. Was not his daughter, the widow Joan Atkins? His grand son Thomas Smith (Gov.) was 33 when he John Atkins died. He was old for this period. As Mr Salley says "a great grandson age" is rare!

Dr Joe Waring said he could find no record of George Smith in Edinburgh University. He mentions a Dr George Smith (1751) in Bone Creek page 386. (Hist of Medicine in S.C. 1670-1825)

I think you are correct about no descendants from James. I saw none in three accounts.

Need reference to date of II Sandgrave TS's (1670-1738) married 19 m 1689 to Anne C V M. Also need ref to " " death date 1710

I plan to cite the various Family bible records copied by MA Read while Miss Annie Smith owned them (1910) for my big chart. I plan to end the chart with the 20 children and their spouses. No children. Our Family Circle carries on from this point.

My story is Thomas Smith of Medway his children and grand children. I will stop 1738. I think I have around 500 references.

George Smith - See Sirmans, "Colonial S.C. p 91, 93, 94. George as brother of II Sandgrave TS is not called Doctor in 1707. In public records he is not called Doctor.

Hope you can help, its very confusing.
