Notes for JAMES R. SMITH:

The 1850 US Federal Census for St. Peter's Parish, Beaufort County, SC gives the following information regarding James R. Smith and his family: James and Harriett were aged 40 and 36 respectively, allowing an estimate for birth years of 1810 and 1814 respectively. James was working as a planter, and the value of his real estate was entered at 1,000. Also living in this household were: Sammy, aged 15; Charles, aged 13; Alexander, aged 8; Mary, aged 6; and Milton, aged 2. Per the census, all individuals in this family group were born in South Carolina. Additionally, Sammy, the eldest, is shown to have been working as a laborer. No other Smiths are reflected on this census page, but other surnames (for possible research later on) are: Wallace, Nichols, Sarlique, Landon, Fitts, Kittles and Blakewood.

The 1860 US Federal Census for St. Peter's Parish, Beaufort County, SC gives the following information regarding James R. Smith and his family: James and Harriet were 54 and 45 respectively, giving estimated birth years of: 1806 and 1815. James was still working as a planter. His real estate was valued at 3,500 and his personal estate at 15,000. Living with them were: Samuel, aged 30; Mary L., aged 20 (Mary may be Samuel's wife or his sister, but there is a 4 year discrepancy in her age if it is his sister); Charles C., aged 18; Sarah, aged 15 (who could have been listed as Mary on the 1850 Census); Alex, aged 13; Milton aged 8; and Rufus, aged 6. Also found on this page (the first line following the family for James R. Smith) is a James H. Smith, who may be related, aged 23, who had a personal estate valued at 1,000. Charles, Sarah and Alex were all attending school at the time of the census. All individuals were born in South Carolina. The issues with the individuals named Mary L. and Sarah may be a result of trying to separate Samuel's wife from his sister. This will be researched further. Other surnames found on this census page are: McDonald; Dewitt, Tindol, Breland, Cleland and Grimes.

The 1870 US Federal Census for St. Peter's Parish, Beaufort County, SC gives the following information regarding James R. Smith and his family: Harriet does not appear on the census so it may be assumed that she has passed on by this time. James is listed as being 50 years old, which would change his birthdate yet again to 1820, but the children listed with him reflect that it is the correct family group (Milton and Rufus, now aged 18 and 16 respectively). James is no longer working as a planter, but is listed as a farmer, with real estate valued at 300 and a personal estate valued at 200. This is a marked difference from his listings on the 1860 census, but it may be as a result of sectioning off his land, as this census shows neighbors of his children, with different dwelling and family numbers (Samuel and his family; James Jr. and his family; and Alex and his family). Also listed with James Sr. are Kate Farris aged 16, Meariah Smith, aged 18, Jacob Smith aged 3, and James Smith aged 1 (this could be "Jane" the individual is given as female). Other surnames listed on this page are: Ellis, Cleland, Grimes, Mew and Stanley.

It should be noted that the difference in the estates of James R. Smith between 1860 and 1870 could very well be related to the civil war. This is being researched.

The 1920 US Federal Census for Pocotaligo, East Part, Jasper County, South Carolina gives the following information on the Powell Smith family: Powell, Lizzie and their two children at the time (Dora and Mack) were all born in South Carolina, as were their parents. The Smith family was renting their home. Powell was 37 at the time of the census and Lizzie 25, giving them estimated birth years of 1883 and 1895 respectively. Powell was working as a farm laborer and termed as "Working Out" on the US Census. From which we can deduce that they were not living on a working farm themselves. Their children, Dora and Mack F., were 3.5 and 7 months old respectively, giving them estimated birth years of 1917 and 1919.

From a notice of "Honorable Discharge from the Army of the United States" comes the following extracted information regarding Farrow J. Smith:

His service number was 4125938; he was honorably discharged the 6th day of January 1919 by reason of "DEm Obligation".

He was born in Jasper, South Carolina.

He was 30 years of age and a farmer when he enlisted.

He had blue eyes, brown hair, fair complexion and was 5 feet 7 inches in height.

The following information was extracted from Farrow J. Smith's Enlistment Record, filed Mar 2 1951 in Discharge Book "World War I", Page 15:

He was Inducted into service on July 23 1918 in Ridgeland, SC, to serve in the first enlistment period. He had never served in the military previously. He was not qualified at the time of induction in marksmanship, gunner qualification or rating; nor in horsemanship. His physical description at discharge was termed good and his Typhoid Prophylaxis was completed (triple) on August 10 1918.

He was not married at the time of discharge.

His character was termed very good.

In the remarks: "No awol or absences under CJ 0457918. Entitled to trainee pay to Ridgeland, SC"

From the World War I Draft Registration Card for Farrow J Smith born 29 Oct 1888 dated June 6 1917:

Farrow was residing in Gillisonville, South Carolina. He was born in Gray, South Carolina. Was married with one child and working as a farmer in Gillisonville for a man called W.J. Ellis.
