

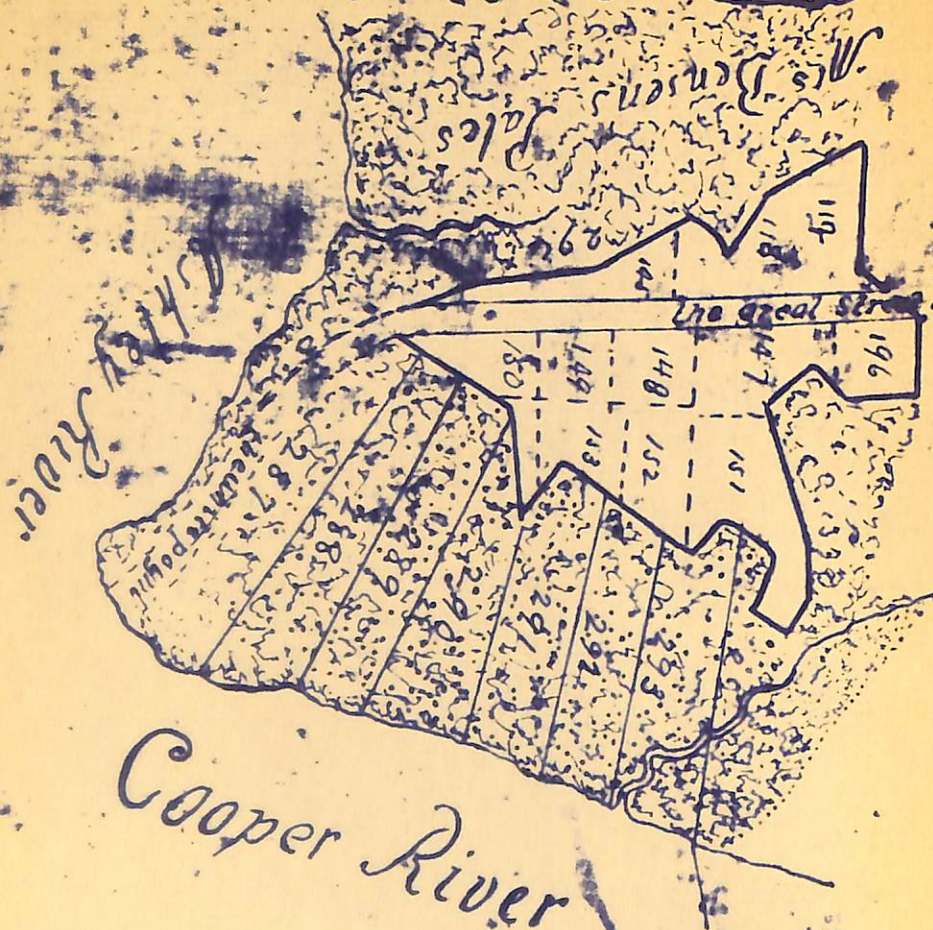

By virtue of a warrant under the hand and Seale of the hono: James Colleton, Esq: Lieutenant & Govern<sup>r</sup> bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day November Anno Domini: 1688 - I have admeasured & laid out unto Thomas Smith Esq: all that poyn<sup>t</sup> of land in Charlestowne, being six acres & commonly knowne by the name of Oyster poyn<sup>t</sup> poyn<sup>t</sup> which s<sup>t</sup> poyn<sup>t</sup> of land is an outport of Charlestowne and butting to the Southward upon Ashely river and to the Northward upon the lot of Robert Collins and bounding to the Eastward upon Cooper Rider and to the Westward upon the impaled lott of Mrs Mary Benson deceased which the abode delineated plat<sup>t</sup> doth represent the true forme and shape thereof together w<sup>th</sup> the true nullings boundaries and Marshes as
